We go through each of the different types of sentences in this section, explaining what the purpose of the type of sentence is, how to use it, and what examples of it look like. Declarative sentences are the most common of the four types of sentences. They are used when you want to make a statement (which may be a fact or an opinion). These proposals end in a period. They can range from a single verb to a much longer sentence, and they usually end in a period. However, imperative sentences can sometimes end with an exclamation point if the order is given with great feeling. As long as the sentence is a team, it is an imperative proposal, not an exclamation point (see below), even if it ends with an exclamation point. Examples: Shut the door! Don't eat the cake until it's cold. Please give me the sauce. Be there by 3:00. This type of sentence is rarely used in professional writing (e.g. newspapers or scientific journals) where so that the author remains objective and sticks to facts rather than emotions. However, however, other types of writing, exclamation points can be an effective way to show emotions in writing and/or evoke strong emotions in your readers. They can help readers understand when a character feels particularly strongly about something, or when something comes as a surprise in a story. Examples: I can't believe we lost!
