

Creating the MLA Works Cited Page

First: Use one of these sites to help you create each entry for your Works Cited page

- Citationmachine.net
- Easybib.com

Next: Follow these rules to create your Works Cited page

- Title the page Works Cited at the top center of the paper (do not underline, bold, or make font larger)
- Put your last name and page number at the top right (just like all the other pages)
- List the sources in alphabetical order (usually by last name)
- Do not number the sources and don't use bullet points
- Double-space each entry and don't put any extra space between each entry
- Indent every line after the first line of each source (this is called a "hanging indent")
- The number of sources you use in your paper should be the same amount you have on the Works Cited page
- If you use a source more than once in your paper, only list it once on the Works Cited page
