We believe that small stories can spark big change. That is why we have made this book available as a free resource for parents, teachers, and community members.




Finn the Dolphin loved splashing in the sparkling blue ocean. He zipped through the waves, leapt high into the air, and dove down deep where the water was cool and calm.
