



# Level 2 Award in Risk Assessment

## Who is this course for?

LEVEL 2 is suitable for anyone who;

- needs a good basic awareness;
- Needs to carry out a basic risk assessment for simple work activities;
- those involved in, or affected by, health and safety management & risk assessment;
- employees, safety representatives, team leaders and those who may be consulted by managers.
- Needs an officially approved qualification, not a poor imitation.

## Topic areas covered

The qualification will enable successful candidate to understand and put into practice (at a basic level) the following:

- ◆ Causes of accidents and ill health.
- ◆ Risk assessment; what the law requires; how far to go, “suitable and sufficient”.
- ◆ Risk assessment; the process.
- ◆ Control measures; some are better than others....
- ◆ The basics of wider health and safety management.

## Why Two Levels?? It's the Test that's different.....

- ◆ The syllabus of Levels 2 & 3 are broadly similar, but there is a big difference in the level of understanding and application required. Having 2 levels allows you to choose the right degree of skill for your staff.
- ◆ Level 2 (“Principles and Awareness”) is about awareness of the principles. Retention of some key facts is tested on the day with a 15 question multiple choice exam. Pass mark is 9 correct answer
- ◆ Level 3 (“Principals and Practice”) requires an assignment to be produced with our supervision, with a guide of 20 or so hours of work to produce it. Here, you get to actually do some risk assessment and show us that you really do understand it! We mark it first, followed by a second mark by the awarding body.

## Supplementary Information

**Pre-requisites:** None, just enthusiasm. Basic English literacy is desirable, but we can accommodate most learning needs, BUT PLEASE DO LET US KNOW of any special requirements learners may have.

We will need a *quiet* room of sufficient size with tables chairs, etc. We can provide all the necessary training equipment if the room is not equipped.

**Duration:** A one-day program, typically 09:00 —16:30, allowing for mid morning/mid pm break & 1/2 hour lunch). Times are entirely flexible, however.

**Cost (Level 2):** £675.00 + mileage & VAT; includes exam fees for up to 10 delegates (15 multi-choice question assessment & certification).
