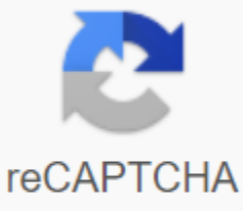

The use of chemicals to kill these abnormal cells began in the 1940s using nitrogen mustard. Since then, many new chemotherapeutic drugs have been developed and tested. Chemotherapy is used to cure certain cancers, control tumor growth, reduce tumors before other treatments like surgery or radiation therapy, relieve pain and other symptoms, and destroy dangerous cells that may be present in the body after surgical removal of the tumor. There is some evidence that fruits and vegetables and the nutrients they contain can reduce the risk of people developing certain types of cancer. The use of alcohol is one of several things that can be definitively linked to an increased risk of cancer. The type of alcohol (beer, wine, liquor) does not affect the risk. One theory is that the risk is related to two chemicals that can damage the DNA of healthy cells: ethanol contained in alcoholic beverages and acetaldehyde formed in the body as alcohol is digested. Cancer usually occurs when an old cell that dies grows out of control and forms a new abnormal cell. If these unwanted abnormal cells gather in chunks, it is called a tumor. It can happen anywhere in the body. Cancer stage grouping is the result of a combination of the first variables collectively referred to as the TNM system. Obesity is a state of having too much body fat for lean body tissue. Obesity is usually measured using a BMI scale representing the body size index. More than two-thirds of American adults are overweight or obese. A study published in the weekly peer-reviewed medical journal BMJ showed that in February 2019, each time the amount of mass-produced processed foods eaten by individuals increased by 10 percent, the risk of developing cancer increased by 12 percent. Processed foods are food made by changing agricultural products from a natural state to another form. For example, use an industrial method to turn corn into high fructose corn syrup or breakfast cereal. Many studies suggest a link between the amount of sugar a person eats and diseases like diabetes, illness, and mental health. Today, evidence linked to sugar consumption and cancer continues to grow, but this problem is still highly debaculed as fructose has been shown to change cell metabolism and increase the activity of proteins that cause cancer. PI3K is the most frequently mutated cancer-promoting gene is a human. Since Dr. Country's discovery, it has been identified as playing a role in 80% of cancers. The idea behind PI3K drugs is that blocking enzymes confuses signals that provide high levels of glucose to cancer, but this is not always the case and not all clinical trials of PI3K inhibitors have been successful.
