## **Book of Stone**

In 1961 Rix Weaver made an extraordinary journey to Uluru, driving over 5000 miles on unsealed roads in an erratic Volkswagen Beetle. She had dropped everything to seize the opportunity when her friend, bushman and poet and Bill Harney told her: "You should come now." Mr. Harney had spent two years as ranger and protector of the site in the company of the last two men to be initiated there. They shared with him some of the rites and rituals connected with Uluru. On Harney's word, the aborigines trusted Rix and explained the form and meaning of some of the sacred chants and symbols.

In this film, Rix, interviewed by Diane Cilento, speaks of her experience of being at this unique sacred site and of the insights that Mr. Harney shared with her. She speaks of how this extraordinary trip brought to life the deep archetypal images of the collective unconscious accessible through ritual and dreams.

In the film Jungian Analyst Sally Kester provides an introduction and she will join us again to introduce the film with a short talk on how Rix taught her about the unconscious and dreams.
