THE SOLICITATION

THE GENERAL CONFESSION

Almighty God, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Maker of all things, Judge of all men, we acknowledge and bewail our manifold sins and wickedness which we from time to time most grievously have committed by thought, word and deed against Your divine Majesty, provoking most justly Your wrath and indignation against us. Absentee Voting With Excuse Begins
You can vote absentee in person (with excuse) at the Board of Elections or apply for an absentee ballot to vote by mail.

JULY
8

Last Day to Register to Vote
Update your registration if you have recently moved, changed your name, haven't voted in a while, never registered, or are off papers.

JULY
21

No Excuse In Person Voting Begins
You can vote in person without an excuse at the Board of Elections or satellite locations.

JULY
22

Last Day to Request An Absentee Ballot
Requests must be received by 5:00 p.m. by your local election authority.

AUG
3

Last Day to Vote Absentee In Person
In person absentee voting ends the day before election day.

AUG
4

ELECTION DAY Polls are open from 6 a.m. - 7 p.m.
