It's a game that combines corporate satire, unfathomable cosmic horror, great characters, and diverse gameplay into one of the most unique AAA titles we've played this year. Also, with the free upcoming DLC, some great Alan Wake tie-in, and incredible animation that pushes the boundaries of what the PS4 can do, it will have the durability of a long-running initial. We're excited about the future and we can't say there's a lot about one game. We finally got that Fallout: New Vegas sequel we were waiting for as a spiritual successor of sorts. Obsidian doesn't reinvent the wheel with the Outer Worlds, and it certainly isn't necessary. The outside worlds provide a comfortable, warm role-playing experience for those who are nostalgic for the old names Fallout and other RPGs. With an extensive narrative that encourages replayability, a compact 20-30 hour story, rampant capitalism, ferocious wildlife, a cast of great mates (with a special mention for Parvati) and all the laser guns you can grab, Obsidian delivers one of the best games of 2019. The power is strong with this Star Wars adventure. Respawn nailed Star Wars with the Jedi: The Fallen Order. It's not just the eponymous game that the fans demanded but it perfectly reflects the feeling that he wields a lightsaber and becomes a real Jedi. Its struggle is impeccable, the level of design is gorgeous, the exploration is useful, the characters are attractive, and it expands into the universe in new and exciting ways. Star Wars Jedi: The Fallen Order combines our favorite elements from Tomb Raider, Uncharted, Metroidvanias and Dark Souls to create an unforgettable action experience. Become a psychic superhero in this supernatural brawl. Who doesn't love psychic powers in games? As you level Jesse, our hero, up you start to feel like a superhero. You can fly, use telekinesis to run enemies, slam into the ground, and even take control of Hiss to make your bets. Obsidian hasn't made many risky decisions in developing this game - and at a time when veteran RPG studios fumble, that's why it's so enjoyable. Borderlands 3 combines the best of both worlds: fun, hectic shooting and character setting, tree craftsmanship, looting, and mission choices we all know and love from RPG. Not to be confused with the outside worlds, this indie Mobius Digital has slowly captured the hearts and minds of many of us here at Android Central. We won't blame you for what you think is gimmicky - you're stuck in a 22-minute loop and have to figure out the mysteries of the solar system to stop the sun from going to a supernova - but that's more than its premise. It is a melancholy but beautiful journey through a world that feels rich and full. Ancient cultures were with a rich inner life, the planets are varied and vast, and the end of the mystery of the mystery For players who don't mind some hard flying controls and love intelligence, this game has just about everything. The strangest game that took the internet by storm and quickly became a favorite meme. Geese jerks and only live to annoy people. This new IP debut has been extremely successful so far and lays a solid foundation for further entries. It can be set in Alan Wake's universe, but Control still manages to create a new world on its own. Remedy seems to be making its own cinematic universe for games with the release of Alan Wake. It's clearly set in the same universe as the aforementioned franchise, but you don't know if you've dug deep into audio management magazines and other collectibles. Control is his own wacky world that lays the groundwork for potential sequels or even further in contact with Alan Wake. The sky is the limit for Remedy. If David Lynch made a video game, it would look very similar to that. Control has been some of our favorite moments of history in games this year. Where else can you traipse through the ever-changing maze by listening to metal music in a way that not only makes sense in the plot, but also cool as hell? This game of equal parts is hilarious, confusing, horrible and fascinating. Not like David Lynch and Twin Peaks: The Return we were glad to see that confusion, a mysterious thing waiting around the next corner. Not only that, but Remedy managed to link it to his previous IP, Alan Wake, in a way that enlivens a decade-long game for future audiences. The cycle of time is replete with possibilities and stories that you create yourself outside of the larger picture. The outer wilderness is mysterious from the very morning. You're exploring the solar system, but you're in a supernova. Then you're stuck in a 22-minute time loop that you need to use to sun from the explosion. Fortunately, you get to do this by exploring the previously unseen solar system, taking in long-gone alien cultures and and it's a great game aesthetically pleasing, but what makes the game worth playing is how you interact with what you find. It's both sad and inspiring, horrible, but reassuring. It's an experience you won't want to miss. Battle Royale games have never looked so good. If you harken back in the early days of 2019, it felt like Apex Legends came out of nowhere. This battle royale respawn has just fallen one day and is immediately appealing to players who wanted an alternative to other multiplayer games like Overwatch and PUBG. It also had a diverse, entertaining cast with a variety of abilities that made for some addictive gameplay. While Obsidian got past success, his last game really proved that it shouldn't work in the IP of a larger company, for example, with the Knights of the Old Republic II: Sith Lords or Fallout: New Vegas.
