

How to Restrict Allowed Content: Region Ratings, Music, Movies, TV Shows, Books, Apps, Siri, Websites & Password Settings

- Launch the **Settings** app from the Home screen of your iPad.
- Tap on **General** and tap on **Restrictions** midway down the list and enter your Restrictions Passcode.
- Scroll all the way to the middle of the Restrictions page and you'll find the **Allowed Content**.

- 2. Music, Podcasts, News & iTunes U: Clean** (*Tap and Turn off Explicit*)
- 3. Movies: PG**
- 4. TV Shows: TV-PG**
- 5. Books: Restricted** (*Tap and Turn off Explicit Sexual Content*)
- 6. Apps: All***
(*We recommend All as some educational Apps such as Chrome has a rating of 17+)
- 7. Siri: Restricted** (*Tap and Turn off Explicit Language*)
- 8. Websites: Restricted**

- *Tap the Websites option and you'll be able to block the Safari browser from loading certain types of websites. You can limit access to certain types of adult content or choose to only allow access to specific websites. You can customize which exact websites are and are not allowed, too.*
