

How to manage Privacy Settings for Apps

- Third-party apps sometimes request access to your **personal information**. For example, an app might request access to your **Twitter** account to make it easier for you to share things with your friends. Another app might request access to **Contacts** to help you connect with the people you know. Apps will ask for permission before accessing your information for the first time. However, you can always manage these Settings under **Privacy**.
1. Launch the **Settings** app from the Home screen of your iPad.
 2. Tap on **Privacy**.
 3. Make sure **Location Services** is On (for *Find My iPad App*)
 4. Turn off Access to all other Apps.
 5. **Diagnostics & Usage: Don't Send.**
 6. **Advertising: Limit Ad Tracking.**
