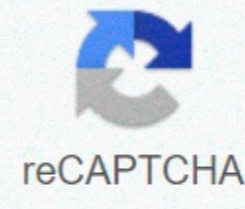

Nsslha to asha conversion

Why join NSSLHA? How do I join NSSLHA? The University of Georgia NSSLHA Chapter participates in several fundraisers each year to bring money to the UGA Speech and Hearing Clinic, including hosting the annual Walk/Run READY, SET, SPEAK! 5K race. Additionally, they report as Junior/Senior Buddies and Reading Buddies at Timothy Road Elementary School, which has been annual community service projects. Just send an email to Kelley Ngo to register. You can then pay your dues via Venmo (@NSSLHA-UGA) or by writing a check to NSSLHA. The cost is \$10 for nsslha membership. Once you've registered, your email will be added to Listserv so you can stay up to date with our meetings and events. Follow us also on Facebook to receive updates from the National Student Speech Language Hearing Association (UGA). What fee do I have to include in my application? To determine the payment included with your application, please refer to the Fees and Fees section of how to apply for certification in speech and language pathology. If you're not sure about the category you belong to or the fees/charges to include in your app, contact Action Center at 800-498-2071. Applicants who do not qualify for an ASHA certificate who voluntarily withdraw their application for ASHA certification will receive application's initial fee, less a non-refundable handling fee of USD 50. Can I pay a rush fee to speed up the processing of my certification application? No, there is no accelerated handling fee available. My NSSLHA membership expired last year. Am I still qualify for the NSSLHA to ASHA conversion discount? To make the quality of the conversion discount, the student must have been a member of the National NSSLHA in the last 2 years of their master's or doctoral degree. If you meet this requirement and your application is received at the ASHA National Office by August 31 of the year following graduation, you may receive a conversion discount. Can I pay the application fee in installments? Not. Payment must be sent in full, only in US currency, with the request. Do I have to pay \$511/\$461/\$455/\$286 per year? No, the initial application fee is a one-time fee paid at the time of the application for certification. How much are dues/fees? Renewal fees/fees are currently \$225 per year for certified members and \$199 per year for certified non-members. Certification fees and membership fees must be paid each year by 31 December. When will I have to renew my dues/fees next time? Certification and membership: If your initial application & payment was received before May 1 of any year, the first renewal will take place on December 31 of the same year. If your initial request & payment was received after May 1 of any year, your first renewal will take place on December 31 of the following year. Certification without membership: If your initial application & payment was received before September 1 of any year, the first renewal will take place on December 31 of the same year. If your initial request & payment is received after September 1 of any year, your first renewal will take place on December 31 of the following year. Currently, standards for the certification of speech and language pathology in 2020 apply. An applicant for a certificate of clinical competence in speech and language pathology (CCC-SLP) shall be applied in accordance with the standards in force at the time of their notification by ASHA and not in accordance with the standards in force at the time of their completion. For more information, see the summary of changes to the new standards and deployment procedures. Please submit your application using our online application system. Applications in accordance with the 2014 SLP standards are no longer accepted or available. Apply now Applying for CCC-SLP If you have completed a program accredited by the Board of Academic Accreditation in Audiology and Speech And Speech Language Pathology (CAA) or from a CAA Candidate Status Program, you can apply online at any time after completing the necessary course and clinical diploma, and after confirmation from the Programme Director that the requirements in the I-V standards are to be Met. The completed application contains fees and fees. Important! All academic courses and clinical practice must be completed before the start of clinical scholarship (CF) experience. If any classes or practices are incomplete, which includes all prerequisites (i.e. basic biology, chemistry or physics, etc.) and basic classes, hours completed for cystic fibrosis experience will not count towards a minimum of 1260 hours. Additional required documents To complete an online application for certification, you must also submit the following documents. Pass the results of praxis exams (sent directly to ASHA from the ETS). Official graduate record*, which verifies the date and awarded degree (can come directly from the institution). Report and speech and language pathology assessment form (SLPCF) report and evaluation form through the online application portal. Disclosure Documents: If you have checked yes when asked to disclose your request, please review the requirements for certified court copies or other legal documents. * Internationally trained candidates: Read certification information for international applicants to find out what you need to apply for an ASHA certificate. ASHA's certification and membership fees and programs are based on the calendar year and are subject to the rates listed below. Applications received between 1 September and 31 December will be processed in the current year, but will include membership and certification for the following year. Please send your payment in full with your request according to the category you choose below. Applicants who do not qualify for an ASHA certificate or who voluntarily withdraw their ASHA certification application will receive

a refund of the initial application fee, less a non-refundable handling fee of \$50. New candidates: Get all the value you can get from your ASHA Certification and Membership. Apply for an ASHA Grad gift, May 1 - August 31, and get up to 20 months of membership for the price of 12. NSSLHA Conversion: \$286For NSSLHA members who have held a national NSSLHA membership for two consecutive years at graduation, and who apply for ASHA membership and certification until August 31 of the year following graduation. Graduate: \$461For applicants for membership and certification within 12 months of graduation date that do not qualify for the NSSLHA conversion rate. ASHA certification and membership: \$511For people who are not eligible for NSSLHA conversions or recent graduate categories. Certification without ASHA membership: \$455For those wishing to obtain a certificate without association membership. Double certification: \$256For people already certified or in the process of certification in one who wish to apply for certification in another area. Note: Applicants certification in both areas at the same time pays fees for a single area certification application. The maintenance of the certificate and/or membership, in addition to the requirements of continuous professional development (if applicable), depends on the payment of annual contributions and fees. Certification timeline Please wait about 6 weeks to check the completed online application and all additional required documentation. Certification cannot be granted until we have checked that all the requirements of the standards have been met. Questions? Contact action center at 800-498-2071 for any questions about applying for an ASHA certificate. Do I need to submit a gift to the Grad (GTTG) app? No, between May 1 and August 31, you will automatically receive a Gift to Grad when you apply for ASHA membership and certification. What is the difference between GTTG and NSSLHA-to-ASHA conversion discount? GTTG is an ASHA benefit that gives students starting their profession up to 20 months of ASHA membership for 12 months — an extended period of membership benefits. NSSLHA-to-ASHA Conversion Discount is an ASHA benefit for students who maintain 2 consecutive years of membership in the NSSLHA. Students who qualify for the conversion discount receive a \$225 discount on initial fees and fees for ASHA membership and certification. A student with a Conversion Discount may also be eligible for a GTC to receive an additional 20 months of membership at the time of application. That's a saving of \$450. Do students who have completed their Doctoral Studies qualify for GTTG? Yes, any graduate who applies for ASHA membership and certification between May 1 and August 31 qualifies for GTTG. When is the best time to apply for GTTG? To use the GTTG program, you must apply between May 1 and August 31. Students should assess the best time to apply based on graduation date and clinical scholarship, if applicable. Should I wait until I finish with my clinical scholarship (CF)/externship to apply for asha membership and certification? You don't have to wait until you complete your CF/externship to apply for asha membership and certification. Consider when you can apply before deciding when to apply. Audiology graduates will be considered candidates in audiology when they apply for membership and certification. Graduates of speech and language pathology can apply before, during or after a clinical scholarship and be considered a candidate in speech. The application must be submitted between 1 May and 31 August. If I apply to ASHA, do I need to renew my nsslha membership to get GTTG? You don't need to renew your NSSLHA membership to get GTTG. GTTG is a benefit for students applying for WA membership Certification. Do I need to be an NSSLHA member to qualify for GTTG? You don't need to be an NSSLHA member to qualify for a Grad Gift. However, the biggest monetary benefit is for those students who have completed two consecutive years of NSSLHA members. Can I submit my application on August 31st and still qualify? The application for membership and certification must be received by the ASHA National Office by August 31 to receive GTTG. Applications received on or after 1 September, regardless of the date of the postmark, shall not be accepted. How can I get more information?
