

Information and Coordination Centre for Dependent Persons and their Families

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About the idea

The essence of the idea is to enable older people to stay at home and in their own communities for as long as possible, with the support of their family, local care institutions, health centers, volunteers and local authorities.

The Centre is a place where a dependent elderly person and their family would receive comprehensive support in reaching every available form of assistance offered by various social assistance and health care entities. An elderly person and their carers would not have to deal with an uncoordinated and hostile system. The employees and volunteers of the centre would help one break through the maze of legal tricks in obtaining the benefits the elderly are entitled to sign up for a doctor's visit, obtain rehabilitation equipment etc. Specialists available in the Centre would strengthen the sense of subjectivity of the beneficiaries and offer their support in crisis situations.

The activities of the Centre would cover three areas: information, education and accompanying.

Benefits of the idea

In the Centre, seniors would receive personalized help- taking into account their location and real needs. Thanks to it, they would have a chance to remain independent and stay in their own environment.
