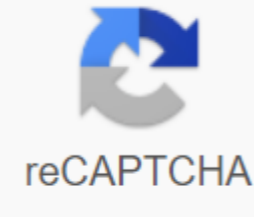

As in other States of India, the head of the State of Odisha is the Governor appointed by the President of India on the recommendation of the central government. His or her post is largely ceremonial. The Chief Minister is the head of government and has the majority of executive powers. Bhubaneswar is the capital of Odishi, home to Vidhan Sabha (Legislative Assembly) and the secretariat. The Orissa High Court, located in Kattaka, has jurisdiction throughout the state. The current Odisha Legislative Assembly is unicameral, comprised of 147 members of the Legislative Assembly (M.L.A). His term of office is five years, unless dissolved earlier. The state of Odisha is represented at the Centre by 21 members of the Lok Sabha parliament and 10 members of parliaments, Rajia Sabhi. There are 21 Lok Sabha constituencies, of which candidates are elected in the general election in Lok Sabha. Members of Rajya Sabha are elected and/or appointed by a member of the Legislative Assembly through their parent political parties. According to the Constitution of India, the governor is the de jure head of state, but the de facto executive power rests with the Chief Minister. After the elections to the Odisha Legislative Assembly, the governor usually invites a party (or coalition) with a majority of seats to form a government. The Governor appoints a Chief Minister, whose Council of Ministers has a collective responsibility to Given that he is always always in the service, the Term of the Chief Minister is five years and is not limited to the term of office. On April 1, 1936, orissa province was formed. The province is under the control of King Paralahemundi Maharaja Krishna Chandra Gajarat Narayan Deo. He ruled until July 1937. There after the All India Congress, party leader Biswanat Das took charge for another two years. Again the king took control before finally being handed over to Dr. Harekrushna Mahatab in 1946. After India had gained its freedom and the constitution was adopted, the State had been persuaded to work in the principles of democracy. Prior to the first elections, Dr. Khariekrushna Mahatab continued to be Odisha's Chief Minister, and was taken over by Nabakrushhna Chowdhury. Here is chief Minister Odisha's list from 1946. Since 1946, there have been 14 chief ministers in Odisha. Serving since 2000, Navin Patnaik of Biju Janata Dal is the current Chief Minister and the longest in Odishi's history.
