

Chopra on Lord Vishnu. It is based on Vishnu Purana, an ancient collection of short stories and scriptures. Vishnu Puran talks about 10 incarnations of Vishnu, as well as other stories such as The Legend of Dhruva. The weekly series first aired on the morning of Sunday, January 23, 2000, on the TV channel z1. The 125 episodes were later released on DD National. The main roles are played by Nitish Bharadwaj as Lord Vishnu and Vajdehi as the goddess Lakshmi. Nitish Bharadwaj previously played the role of Lord Krishna in Chopra's television adaptation of the Mahabharat epic. The music is written by Raj Kamal, who also worked on Mahabharata. The title song was sung by Shankar Mahadevan, and the songs decoding the summary of each episode were sung by Mahendra Kapoor. During the COVID-19 pandemic in India, DD Bharati and See TV began re-airing episodes to entertain the public during the lockdown. From July 6, 2020 it started at DD National at 8:00 pm to 8:45 p.m. with the first episode again. The episode guide Vishnu is the defender of the universe (episode 1) Episode 1: The narrator of Mother Earth, Dharti Maa, introduces himself to the audience. After the world ended in fire and flood, only the supreme God Vishnu survived. Brahma creates the world and the first people, Manu and Shappupu, who wander in pristine nature and fall in love. The story of Dhruva (episodes 2-6) Episode 2: King Uttanpada, Manu and son of Shatarup, is seduced by his ambitious younger wife Suruc and neglects his eldest queen Suniti and her five-year-old son Dhruva. Suruc threw Dhruva off his father's knees, and Uttanpada does not intervene. Suruc tells the unfortunate boy that no one but Lord Sri Vishnu, the supreme god, can give him the right to sit on his father's lap now. Episode 3: Dhruva leaves the palace in search of Lord Sri Vishnu. Goddess Lakshmi pleads with Lord Sri Vishnu to protect Dhruva and takes matters into her own hands, showing himself as a snake to save the child from a gang of Dakoys. Manu gives Uttanpada talk and Uttanpada and Suniti reconcile and seek out their son. Sage Narada, sent Vishnu guides Dhruva into the forest and gives him a mantra to sing. Episode 4: The Goddess Parvati, at the request of the goddess Lakshmi, protects Dhruva by sending her lion to protect the child from wild beasts. Dhruva asks Narada for further instructions and, on his advice, refuses to eat and drink. Lord Sri Vishnu tells the goddess Lakshmi, however, that he cannot descend into the world for just one person. Meanwhile, the king of the virgins, Indra, fears that Dhruva may ask for the throne of Lord Sri Vishnu. Indra sends axar Rakshita under the guise of Dhruva's mother, but Dhruva does not even notice her. Episode 5: Uttanpada is unhappy, and Indra's attempts to thwart Dhruva's repentance fail. Dhruva begs Narada for further advice and, obeying the instructions of his guru, stops breathing. The whole universe is standing still. Now that just over one person has been injured, Vishnu appears before Dhkruva. Episode 6: Dhruva asks Lord Sri Vishnu why his father did not allow him to kneel. Lord Sri Vishnu takes Dhruva to his knees and heals his burns and hunger. Dhruva's questions are disappearing; it feels completely blissful. Lord Sri Vishnu instructs Dhruve to return to his people and be an example of an enlightened king. Dhruva returns home and forgives Suruc, because if it were not for her, he would never have found Lord Sri Vishnu. Matsya Avatar and Theft Veda (episodes 7-9) Episode 7: Dharti Ma tells that the sage Kashyapa had three wives, Diti, Aditi and Dana, mothers daiiyas (demons), virgins (gods) and danavas (monsters or giants or demons), respectively. Lord Sri Vishnu trusts the four scriptures, vedas, Brahma, to be passed on to humanity. Heahagriwa, Dana's son, believes that this is unfair to demons, and determines to keep the Vedas away from humanity. Brahma worries that humanity is too evil to get the Vedas, and goes to advise Shiva about purifying the earth in the first place. While Brahma is on the sidelines, Heagriwa kidnaps vedas (which are in the form of four little boys) and puts them in their underwater lair. Episode 8: Shiva agrees to flood the earth to destroy all evil life and cleanse it; Brahma can create humanity anew and give them the Vedas. While Manu is swimming, the tiny fish floats in his hands and asks for protection. Manu takes him home, but he grows to gigantic sizes overnight, and he releases it into the ocean, where he realizes that the fish are none other than Lord Sri Vishnu. Like Macchia, the fish, Lord Sri Vishnu warns Manu of the coal flood and asks him to save something important in the boat. Episode 9: Ayagriva decides to destroy Veda, but Matsya appears first and kills Ayagriva. Manu and Shatarapa collect plants and animals, deciding to save everything, rather than have the pride of thinking that they know what is valuable and what is not. At the last minute, Manu is thinking about bringing in seven of the original wise men, Saptarishi. Teh Manu's boat is abandoned by the storm, but Matzya tows her to safety. After the flood, Lord Sri Vishnu again gives veda to the nine survivors. Kurma Avatar and churning the ocean (episodes 10-17) Episode 10: At the funeral of Gayatrika defeats another Dane, Harsada, for the kingdom. The Danawas immediately attack the maidens in retaliation for the death of Heagriwa, but Lord Indra easily defeats them. Lord Indra boasts of his victory. Episode 11: Shukracharya, a Danawa guru, rebukes his followers for attacking without a plan. He forms his own plan: to ask Lord Shiva about the Mantra of Sanjivani, a mantra that allows the dead to return to life. Lord Indra goes to Lord Shiva to prevent this, but Shukracharya attracts Lord Shiva's first attention and gets the right to try Shiva's repentance to a danava to choose her husband. Episode 17: Lord Brahma holds a Swayamvara ceremony for the goddess Lakshmi to choose her husband. She chooses Lord Sri Vishnu. The churning of the ocean continues, and amrit appears and quickly stolen Swarbhan. Lord Sri Vishnu appears as Mohini, a beautiful woman, and dazzles the Danawa, inviting the virgins to watch them drink amrite. She gives it devas first, however, and there is no one left for danavas. Swarbhanu disguises herself as a maiden and receives amrit, but Lord Sri Vishnu cuts off his head. Narasimha Avatar and the Trials of the Prahlada of Faith (episodes 18-39) benefit Hiranyakashi (episodes 18-21) Episode 18: The four holy sons of Lord Sri Vishnu, but cannot enter the gates of Jay and Vijay. The Saints curse Jaya and Vijay to be born three times the Asura and be killed by Lord Sri Vishnu each time. Jaya and Vijaya were born as Hiranyaksha and Hinanyakhasiu. Hiranyaksha steals the earth and hides it. Lord Sri Vishnu is embodied as Varah and kills Hiranaksha. Hignakaship vows revenge. Episode 19: To take revenge, Hinanyakashipu does repentance to receive the benefit of Lord Brahm. Indra tries to help Lord Sri Vishnu, breaking repentance, but every attempt is thwarted by Shukracharya. In desperation, Indra decides to kidnap his wife Hiranakashisha Cayadha and kill her future son. However, Sage Narada stops Indra and rescues Cajadha. In his ashram, Narada sings the name of Lord Sri VishnuAyadhu, and her unborn son hears him. Episode 20: Lord Brahma postpones the answers to the prayers of Hinnyakaship, but finally has to do so. Hinyakashippu asks for immortality, but Lord Brahma says that no being can do it. He should ask for something else. Hinyakashiu asks Lord Brahma to make sure that he, Hinyakashipu, cannot be killed day or night, in the building or outside the building, on the ground or in heaven, by God, by man or animal, or by any weapon. Lord Brahma provides all the good. Narada tells Hiranyakaship about his wife's whereabouts. Episode 21: Sayadhu says she has never been so happy and asks to stay with Narada until her son is born. Hinyakashiu agrees and celebrates his good by declaring himself God and forbidding the worship of Lord Sri Vishnu. Swarbhanu joins the court of Hinanyakaship. Kayadhu gives birth to a son Prahlad and gets permission to stay with Narada until Prahlad goes dead. Hiranyakashipu forces Narada to promise not to name Vishnu before Prahlad. The story of Prahlad (episodes 22-34) Episode 22: Prahlad grew up in a cute little boy who is completely devoted to Lord Sri Vishnu (whom he knows by his 999 other names) and mastered all the yoga Narada taught him. Sayadhu and Prahlad return to the kingdom of Asura and sends Pralad to school. At school, Prahlad is shocked to see his father's idol and refuses to worship him. Instead, Hiranjakashipu sends Prahlad into exile into the desert. Swarbhan follows Prahlad and does not give him food or drink. Episode 25: Lord Sri Vishnu releases his Sudarshan Chakra and chases Swarbhana. Prahlad's classmates find him and bring him food. Hiranyakashiu sends soldiers who throw Prahlada off the mountain. Lord Sri Vishnu catches Prahlada and carefully puts him in a grain cart. Episode 26: A grain cart was delivering to the court of Hinanyakaship. Infuriated by the survival of Prahlad, Hiranyakashipu puts his son in prison. Swarbhan tries to poison Prahlad, but Shiva shows up and drinks poison. Episode 27: Sister Hiranyakashipu Singhika and her husband Prahlad to make a decision. Episode 39: Prahlad asks Sudhanva if he objects to Prahlad being a judge. Sudhanva agrees. Kayakhu and Prahlad's wife try to convince Hiranyakashipu enlists the help of Singhika and Vigrachitti in the murder of Prahlada. They offer to send Prahlad to their kingdom, Kamarupa, with a letter. In the letter, their son Aahlad will tell him to throw Prahlad into a snake pit. Aahlad tells Prahlad that he will be hanged to visit the temple of Lord Sri Vishnu. Episode 28: Prahlad is locked in a snake pit where he prays to Lord Sri Vishnu. Sayaedhu also prays to Lord Sri Vishnu to protect his son. Sudarsan Chakra appears in a snake pit, and snakes disappear. Prahlad opens his eyes and sees the idol of Lord Sri Vishnu. Meanwhile, the escaped snake was bitten by Aahlad, and he died. Prahlad is devastated; he prays to Lord Sri Vishnu for his brother's life, and Lord Sri Vishnu brings Aahlad back to life. Episode 29: Hiranyakashipu, Singhika and Vivraciti hear about Aahlad's death and all swear revenge. Prahlad and Aahlad go to the palace together, but Singhika only pretends to be happy and persuades Pralad to go to the fire with her. Aahlad becomes a devotee of Lord Sri Vishnu. Hinanyakashipu announces a festival for the fire court. Episode 30: Singhika and Prahlad come into the fire. Sinhika is on fire, Prahlad is protected. In revenge, Prahlada puts Prahlad in an enchanted dream and throws him into the ocean, but the ocean god protects Prahlad on the command of the goddess Lakshmi. goes to the shore of the sea and begs the ocean to return his son. Episode 31: Goddess Lakshmi asks the ocean god to return Prahlad to Repent; he's doing it. Shukracharya proposes to arrange the death of Prahlad. He wants to refer to the demoness of Crete and orders his sons Shand and Amark to do so. Episode 32: Shand and Amark perform the ceremony of Crete. Demoness appears, but Sudarshan Chakra again defends Prahlad, so Crity kills Shand and Amarka. Shukracharya is devastated. Prahlad reproaches Shukracharya for being a bad guru and directs his father Hiranakaship on the path of selfishness. Prahlad selflessly prays that Lord Sri Vishnu will revive Shand and Amarka, and they become his disciples. Episode 33: Hiranyakashipu decides to kill Prahlada himself. He orders his son to hug a red hot iron pole. Brahma pleads with Lord Sri Vishnu to do something to overcome the good. Lord Sri Vishnu appears as Narasimha with the torso of a man and the head of a lion, who is both a god, a man and an animal, and kills Hiranyakashisha at dusk, on the threshold of a palace suspended in the air on his thighs, bare hands and sharp claws. Brahma, Shiva, Narada and the goddess Lakshmi are unable to calm Narasimha, but it is Prahlad who succeeds. Episode 34: Prahlad performs his father's last rites after Aahlad refuses. Prahlad will not allow Kayadhu to commit sati. Goddess Lakshmi loves Prahlad, but Lord Sri Vishnu loves all his children, even wicked children such as Shukracharya. Prahlad and Virochan (episodes 35-39) Episode 35: Aahlad abdicates. Prahlad, now an adult and king, is the administration of justice. Shukracharya plans to control Prahlad Virochan's son. Episode 36: Shukracharya sends a virochan hunt, though Prahlad disapproves. During the storm, Virochan rescues Sudhanva, the son of the sage Anguira, from a falling tree. Both suffered and together they seek refuge in the cottage of the sage Vatz. Both fall in love with the daughter of the sage Deepavali. Episode 37: Pralad searches the forest and finds his son. Later, both Virochan and Sudhanva return to the hermit and offer Deepavali. When she cannot choose, Virochan draws her sword on Sukhanva and kidnaps Deepavali, taking her to the Shukracharya ashram. Episode 38: Saptarishi informs Prahlad about the actions of his sons, and Prahlad immediately rescues Deepavali, to side with Shukracharya. When neither Deepawali nor her father can decide between the two boys, her father asks Prahlad to make a decision. Episode 39: Prahlad asks Sudhanva if he objects to Prahlad being a judge. Sudhanva agrees. Kayakhu and Prahlad's wife try to convince Prahlad to decide in favor of Virochan, but Prahlad says that Virochan was wrong, that he used force, and that he decides that Deepavali should marry Sudhranva. Virochan humbly admits his mistakes. Lord Sri Vishnu and the goddess Lakshmi appear and praise Prahlad. Vamana Avatar and Mahabali (episodes Episode 40: Sayadhu dies. Prahlad renounces peace and crowns Virochan. Virochan marries Vishalakshi from Danawa. Shukracharya's father Sage Brig, foresees danger for Virochan. Vishalaakshi gives birth to a son, Bali. Episode 41: Virochan completes the repentance for his safety offered by the sage Brigou, and receives from Surya, the sun god, a protective crown. Bali goes to school. Virochan announces that no god but Lord Sri Vishnu should be worshipped, angering Indra. Indra's wrath worries Lord Sri Vishnu. Episode 42: While Virochan travels alone, Indra cheats on him, drugs him, steals his crown and kills him. Bali, now grown up, vows to take revenge on Indra and attack the sky alone – and brutally murdered Indra and the Virgin. Lord Sri Vishnu is furious with Indra and after forcing him to return Bali's body, washes the maiden's hands forever. Episode 43: Shukracharya brings Bali back to life with the Mantra of Sanjiwani and asks that in return Bali bring him the crown of Indra. Bali attacks the heavens, captures Indra and other virgins, forbids their worship and manufactures them on earth. Episode 44: Aditi turns in vain to his sister Diti for forgiveness of the virgins. Lakshmi showers Bali with riches after he worships her. When Bali hears that the virgins are worshipping on the ground, he decides to conquer the land; Shukracharya is delighted. At The Request of Narada, Pralade tries to convince Bali not to attack the ground. Lakshmi also addresses Bali in vain. Episode 45: Bali invades the ground. Aditi pleads with Lord Sri Vishnu to forgive her sons and fulfill her promise to be born from her womb. Lord Sri Vishnu is embodied as Vamana, a little man. Lord Brahma, Saraswati, Lord Shiva, Kashyap, Brihaspati and the virgins attend the birth and bring gifts. Episode 46: Lord Sri Vishnu explains to Indra that he is incarnated as a beggar. Shukracharya tries to resist the birth of Lord Sri Vishnu by ordering Bali to sacrifice Ashwamedh. Vamana interrupts the Igna and asks Bali for three steps. Bali provides a boon. Vamana grows up and covers all three worlds in his stride, with a third stepping on Bali's head and pushing him deep under the world. Parashurama Avatar and Kshatriyas (episodes 47-63) Definition of Young Parshuram (episodes 47-52) Episode 47: Lord Sri Vishnu forgives and blesses Bali. A new story begins. The Brahmins (priests) were supreme at this age, and the Kshatriya (warriors) began to resent this. King Kartavirya Arjuna (Sahasrjuung) strikes the son of Saint Jamdagni and is summoned to the court of the sage. Episode 48: The Brahmins force Sahasarardjun to apologize. Embarrassed, Sahasrjuung gets along with other kings and forms a plan to steal the cows of the sage Jamdagni and stop the state grants of the Brahmins. Lord Sri Vishnu promises Lakshmi that he will protect the weak. Episode 49: People provide brahmins. Sages accuse King Sahasarardjun of stealing cows. Angry, Sahasarardjun burns the ashram of the sage Jamdagni.... over and over again. Lord Sri Vishnu was born as Parshuram, the son of Saint Giamdagni and his wife Renuki. Episode 50: Saint Giadagni doesn't want young Parshuram to learn martial arts, as it's not suitable for brahms. But Parshuram still trains. Parshuram kills four soldiers who persecute him in the temple of Shiva. Episode 51: Shiva appears and offers to teach Parshuram for ten years. Sahasarardjun turns to his allies and captures their kingdoms. Parshuram renounces the caste and goes to Mount Kailash, where Shiva accepts him as a student. Sahasarardjun meets Ravan, fights him and takes him prisoner. Episode 52: Sahasarardjun jails Ravan after discovering that Ravan cannot be killed. Parshuram is undergoing ten years of training. At the end, Shiva gives him an axe. Renuka goes to reason with Sahsarardjun, and he lures her to the palace. Family Problems Sage Jamdagni (episodes 53-57) Episode 53: Renuka fights Sahasarardjun, injuring and cursing him. Sahasarardjun's wife wants her to die. Jamdagni accuses Renuk of infidelity. Renuka's four sons deny their father the destruction of their mother, but Parshuram, arriving home, promises to obey the order before knowing what it is. Episode 54: Parshuram obeys his father and beheads Renuk. Jamdagni offers him any benefit; Parshuram asks to bring Renuku back to life. Jamdagni asks Renuki for forgiveness. Parshuram confronts Sahasarardjun, but does not kill him after Sahasrjun's wife asks for mercy. Sage Vasista visits Jamdagni with the gift cow Sushila and Anika, her tutor. Episode 55: Sahasarardjun's Army Attacks the Hermit. Parshuram kills them all, and Jamdagni tells him to leave. Sahasarardjun offers Ravan his freedom in exchange for defeating Parshuram; Ravan refuses. Shiva instructs Parshuram to free his devotee Ravan. Episode 56: Parshuram frees Ravana. Sahasarardjun's army is unsuccessfully searching for Parshuram. The sage of Jamdanya forbids ashram students to join the guerrilla army of Parshuram. Anamika proposes to disseminate information and recruit soldiers from other ashrams. Episode 57: In order to be free to go on her mission, Anamika lies and tells Jamdagni and Renuk that she married Parshuram. Parshuram is angry. Sahasarardjun's four sons spy on the ashram in disguise and crave Sushila. When they try to take her by force, Jamdagni is finally awakened and fights them. Revenge of Parshuram (episodes 58-63) Episode 58: Sahasararjun attacks sage Jamdagni, injuring him and stealing Sushila. Parshuram picks her up from the palace, but Sahasarardjun's sons are the first to reach the ashram and kill Jamdagni. Sahasrjuung asks the sage Vishwa somer in the direction of Kshatriya and is strictly

rejected. Episode 59: The queen of Sahasrardjun after failing to convince husband apologise and end the war. Twenty-one king Kshatriya joins Sahasrjun; Brahmin's rally in Parshuram. The sons of Sahasrardjun plot to kidnap Anamika. Parshuram gives his army a brisk conversation. Episode 60: Sahasrardjun's Sons Attack Renuk and Anamika. Anamika kills itself, not is used as a hostage. Sahasrjun sends his sons to the defense, but Parshuram throws them out and kills them one by one. Episode 61: Parshuram gives his mother Sahasrardjun's sons the head. She dies unhappy that her son is so vindictive. Sahasrardjun vows to avenge his sons. Episode 62: Sahasrardjun tries to trap Parshuram. Parshuram offers peace in exchange for an apology from Sahasrarjun. Sahasrardjun refuses. Parshuram kills Sahasrardjun. Episode 63: Parshuram visits Lord Shiva to return his bow. Shiva asks him to give either Ravana or Janak - both his devotees. Dissatisfied with Ravan's behavior, Parshuram leaves without giving him a bow. Along the way, he meets Shrivankumar and his parents. Satisfied with his reception at Janak's court, Parshuram gives a bow to Janaka. Avatar and Ravan's Rama (episodes 64-122) of Ravana's atrocities, Sravan's death and Dastrata's marriage to Kaikei (episodes 64-67) Episode 64: Dasharatha accidentally kills Shravan while hunting and is cursed by Shravan's blind parents. Episode 65: Dasharata goes to help Kaiyapa repe! Ravan's attack. When his chariot is killed, the young man takes the job. The young man turns out to be the daughter of the king, Kaikei, in disguise. Episode 66: Dasharata defeats Ravan in battle. Kaikei saves Dasharate's life twice, and he offers her two benefits that she may have fulfilled at any time in the future. Kaikei wants to marry Dasharat and asks his two queens if they agree. Episode 67: Guru Dasharathi Sage Wasist arranges a marriage that takes place. Meanwhile, Ravan continues to pursue the wise men, and Lord Vishnu decides that he must be embodied to stop Ravan. Buna Ravana and the Births of Rama and Sita (episodes 68-78) Episode 68: Dasharatha asks Wasishta for help in performing the Yagra (victim) to receive the children. Ravan hordes kill a sage, and blood falls in a field in the kingdom of Janaka. This leads to starvation. Episode 69: The Sage of Narada has learned his lesson from Lord Sri Vishnu. Episode 70: Ravan stops his younger brother Vibhishan from worship. Episode 71: On the advice of his younger brother Kumbhakarna, Ravan performs repentance and asks for good. Episode 72: Lord Sri Vishnu asks the goddess Lakshmi to be embodied with him. Episode 73: Lord Sri Vishnu was born as Ram. Ravan is preparing to attack the maiden. Episode 74: Ravana's son Meganate defeats the maiden. Laxmi was born as Sita and found by Janak as he plows the field to stop the famine. Episode 75: Mantara, a servant of Kaikei, makes an unsuccessful attempt to kill the child of Shri Rama. Ravan mocks the captive maidens. Dasharatha The vasist takes on the education of his four sons, Rama, Lakshman, Bharata and Shatmunna. Episode 76: Sri Ram asks the sage Wasista to follow the religion. Janak invites Sage Gautam to become Sita's teacher. Episode 77: Sita refuses to study with Gautama because Gautam unfairly turned his wife Akhaly into stone. Episode 78: The narrator, Dharti Ma, sums up the incarnation of Lord Sri Vishnu so far. Ram wins Sita (episodes 79-87) Episode 79: . Episode 80: Four brothers finish their education. The sacrifices of the sage Vishwamitra disturb Tataka, the demon yakshi Episode 81: Dasharatha offers to send his army against Tataka, but Sage Vishwamitra asks Ram alone. But Lakshman, who is inseparable from Rama, also leaves. Episode 82: Tataka attacks Rama with magic; he must use a celestial weapon to kill her and her sons Subahu and Marichak. Episode 83: Janak invites Sage Vishwamitra to Sita's sivaamwara. Vishwamicra brings Rama and Lakshman with him. Ram frees Akhalya from gautama's curse. Episode 84: Janak imposes the condition on Sivamvare; only those who can lift Shiva's bow will be eligible. Bharat and Shaptugan join the sage Vishwamir, Rama and Lakshman in Swayamwar. Episode 85: Ram and Sita meet in a flower meadow and are amazed. Sita prays to the goddess Gauri. Gauri promises Sita that Ram will be her husband. Episode 86:Ravan goes to swayamvara and is unable to lift the bow. Ram picks it up easily. Episode 87: Parshuram knows about the bow moving and comes to confront Ram. He was reassured by Lakshman, who explains that Ram respects Lord Shiva. Preparations for the wedding begin. Plot vs. Rama (episodes 88-98) Episode 88: Casey is thrilled with the wedding, but Mantara is not. Sage Vishwamitra proposes that Sita's three sisters marry three Rama brothers. Episode 89: A quadruple wedding will take place and the couple return to the capital of Dasharathi, Ayodhu. Episode 90: Casey is very happy to see his son Bharata with his wife Mandawi. Mantara opposes Casey's plan to give Sita his jewelry. Dasharatha wants to resign and crown King Rama. Ram believes that Bharat would be a better choice. Episode 91: Bharat is summoned to visit Keikai's sick parents. The court decides that Ram should be king. Episode 92: Mantara tells Casey that if Ram is crowned instead of Bharata, Casey will be mistreated. Episode 93: Mantara urges Casey to use two unfulfilled blessings to prevent Rama's coronation. Episode 94: Keikai asks Dasharatha to fulfill her two blessings by crowning Bharat and (2) sending Ram into exile for 14 years. Dasharatha is devastated. Episode 95: Dasharatha pleads with Ram to seize the crown anyway, but Ram says, as an obedient son, he must help his father keep his promises. Ram asks Casey to bless him. Episode 96: Sita decides to accompany Rama into exile. Sumitra wants to be queen Casey return her pleas, but the queen queen agrees that it is very important to keep the promise. Episode 97: Lakshman also decides to accompany Rama into exile. Ram, Sita and Lakshman dress up in abdicated clothes. Episode 98: Lakshman asks his wife Urmila to stay so that Lakshman is fully dedicated to serving Ram. It's a sad show. Ram goes into exile; Mount Bharata (episodes 99-107) Episode 99: Dasharatha tries to convince Sita and Lakshman to stay behind. Ram promises Casey that he will not allow anyone to rebel against Bharata as king. Dasharatha never wants to see Casey again. Episode 100: Sri Ram leaves and meets a friend, Nishadraj Guha, who helps the three cross the river. Bharat and Shatragun start at home with the palace of Keikei's parents. Dasharatha sends his Prime Minister Sumant to bring back Rama. Episode 101: Sri Ram rejects Sumant's requests to return. Lord Shiva explains the actions of Ram and Dasharathi Parvati. Episode 102: Dasharatha dies of grief. Bharat and Shatlugan arrive home and are devastated to hear of their brothers' exile and their father's death. Bharat renounces the crown and decides to return Rama. Episode 103: Bharat learns that his mother and Mantara have designed the whole plot and are devastated. At the request of Sage, Vash bharat holds his father's funeral. Episode 104: Devi Sita has a bad dream about Ayodhaya. Casey feels guilty about Dasharatha's death. Sumant obeys the last wish of Dasharatha and Otawa for the funeral. Episode 105: Casey grieves. Sri Ram, Devi Sita and Lakshman visit the sage Bhardwaj in Prayaga, merging three sacred rivers: the Ganges, yamuna and Saraswati. Episode 106: Bharat asks Casey to go with him in search of Sri Rama. Devi's father, Sita Janak, hears all the news, including that Bharat went after Ram and took the army. Janak's on his way to them. Episode 107: Shri Ram, Devi Sita and Lakshman visit the sage Valmiki, who writes the life story of Rama, in Chitrakut. Lakshman sees the Bharata army and is afraid of attack. Maricha then calls for help and Sita, hearing, sends Lakshman. Devi Sita is now alone, and Ravan kidnaps her, killing Jatai. When Ravan flies through the air, Devi Sita throws his jewelry. Episode 112: In the island kingdom of Rawan, Lanca, Devi Sita is held captive by Trijata and other demons in the grove. Surpanah is thrilled, but Ravan's mother and others warn Ravan that it will cause problems. Ram and Lakshman are looking for Devi Sita. Episode 113: Ram blesses Shabari, the untouchable saint. Sugreev, prince of the Vanar kingdom, and Hanuman, the mighty vanar, the son of the God of the Wind of Yayu, find the jewelry of Devi Sita and show them to Rama. Episode 114: Sugreev tells his story: he left his brother King Bali, who fought with asura in a cave, sincerely thinking that Bali was dead, and took the throne as regent until Bali's son Angaj grew up. However, Bali did not die and returned angry, beating Sugrovov. Ram kills Bali for his wrong actions. Grateful Sukhreev orders his army to find Devi Sita. Episode 115: Angad, Hanuman and their friend the King of the Bears Jambavan meet brother Jataya Sampaat, who tells them that Devi Sita is overseas in Lanca. Hanuman jumps across the ocean and finds Devi Sita and is friends with Vibhishan. Ravan gives Devi Sita a deadline: marry him in a month or she will be forced. Episode 116: Ravan Aksh's youngest son attacks Hanuman and is killed. Megnad takes Hanuman prisoner. Ravan has been waiting for Hanuman's tail. Hanuman burns the town of Lanca to the ground. Episode 117: Hanuman tells Ram about Ravan's deadline. The army of Rama, Lakshman and Sugreev reaches the seashore. Vibhishan advises Ravana to return Devi Sita, and Ravan threw Out Vibhishan. Vibhishan joins Ram and tells him how to cross the sea. Monkey brothers Neil and Thall build the Ram Bridge sends Angad as ambassador to Ravan, in case there is a way to prevent war. Battle of Ravan (episodes 117-121) Episode 117: Angad successfully opposes Ravan, but Ravan will not tolerate it. Episode 118: War Begins. Megnad injures Lakshman with celestial weapons, and Hanuman takes the grass of Sanjeevni - along with the whole mountain on which she grows - to cure Lakshman. Ravan and Sri Ram have their ultimate confrontation. Ram shows that he to stop stop Atrocities. Vibhishan tells Ram the secret of Ravan's murder, which can grow new heads - shoot the navel instead. Ram kills Ravan. Episode 121: 14 years old and Vibhishan, now king of Lanca, lends Sri Ram. Devi Sita and Lakshman his flying chariot so they can return to Ayodhya on the right day and not worry Bharata. The exiles happily return to Ayodhu and Bharat. Krishna Avatar (episodes 122-125) Episode 122: Mother Earth concludes that whenever it was riddled with sinners, whenever the human race was threatened - the Creator of the Universe, God embodied Himself. She sums up 10 incarnations of Vishnu, starting with the incident of Jaya and Vijay, who were born twice as demons and became enemies of God because of the curse, and God embodied himself as Varah, Narasimha, and Sri Ram to kill Hiranaksha, Hiranyakashisa, Kumbhakarna, and Ravan. In the form of Kans, Jaya spread terror in Mathur. Tran tyran Kans married his sister Devaki with his friend Vasudeva. He is informed that the God of Death was waiting for this union, as the eighth son of Devaki will kill him. He puts his sister and thou in jail to kill their sons. Kans kills six of Devaka's sons, but Vasudeva's first wife, Rohini, took their seventh son, who later became known as Balarama. Lord Krishna is born as the eighth son. Kans sends the demon queen Putan to kill Krishna. Baby Krishna sucks his life. Lord Krishna as a child performs Lilas with cow friends. Kans is having nightmares. Krishna kills an elephant Kansa Kuvallapade. Krishna appears in various forms in Rangshal. Krishna kills Kansa. Episode 123: Using scenes from previous volumes, this episode summarizes ten incarnations of Lord Vishnu. The first incarnation was like a fish to protect Manu and punish the demon Hayagriva, who stole the four Vedas that Brahma created for the good of humanity. Angered by the murder of Gayagriva, the demon Hiranyaksha kidnapped Mother Earth, thus threatening the entire human race. This required the third incarnation of Vishnu as a boar. He killed Hiranyaksha and saved Mother Earth. The threat of demons increases especially after their Guru Shukracharya received a precious mantra from Shiva for giving new life to dead demons. To bestow immortality on the gods, it was decided to receive the Elixir by churning out the ocean. To lift the mountain from the sea for churning, Lord Vishnu took the incarnation of the Turtle. To avenge the death of his brother, the demon Hinanyakashipu received a blessing from Brahm, which made his death almost impossible. He forbade Vishnu's devotion on earth and forced people, including his son, to worship him. To put an end to his atrocities, Lord Vishnu made his son Prahlad his ardent devotee. Hinyakashitu used various methods to kill his son. Lord Vishnu accepted the incarnation of Narasimha destroy it. To put an end to the arrogance of the King of Bali, Lord Vishnu took Waman Avtar - His fifth incarnation. When the kings began to forget their duty as administrator and closed the hermits and schools, Lord Vishnu incarnated himself as Parshuram, and then in the seventh incarnation of Rama. To rid the world of the injustices of Kans and Kauravas, Lord Vishnu accepted the eighth incarnation as Lord Krishna. And recently, when deception was at its zenith, when priests spread the evil of superstitions in society, Lord Vishnu took the ninth incarnation - Lord Gautam Buddha - to give a new direction of nonviolence to the world. While Balarama worships in the southern regions of India as eight avatars, with Krishna as the ninth, unlike northern India, where Krishna worships as the eighth and Balaram is not included as an avatar. The current era is called Kalyug. In Srimad Bhagwad, the great sage Vyasa said that in the final stage of Kalyug Lord Vishnu would reincarnate himself as Kalki. Thus concludes the sacred Vishnupuran. Episode 124: This episode uses several important scenes from Dr. B.R. Chopra's Mahabharat series to depict the importance of women in Indian mythology. It addresses the issue of Rukmin's marriage to Krishna, which emphasizes a woman's right to have a greater say in choosing her life partner. It also covers the story of subhadra Arjuna's abduction with the help of Lord Krishna. Episode 125: This latest episode also uses material from the TV series Mahabharat TV. It describes the benefit that was given to Krishna Shishupala and the death of Shishupala in Rajasui Yagna in Indraprast. It also shows the narration of Bhagavad-Gita. Krishna takes Arjuna to the middle of the battlefield on a chariot. Arjuna sees people on the battlefield and tells Krishna: Winning in the kingdom after killing your own relatives is too heavy a price. I prefer to be beggar if that's the price I have to pay for our throne. Krishna Arjuna's teachings on the battlefield form the basis of Bhagavad Gita. Unable to satisfy Arjuna's hopeless conscience, Krishna gives Arjuna divine vision and stuns him with his Vishwaarop (divine manifestation). Arjuna is comforted and enlightened. He realizes that the pure seek the spirit while the unclean are trapped in Prakriti (matter). He agrees to selflessly stick out his duty, raises the bow of The Gandvia and prepares to fight the Kaurava.
