Setlist by X at The TLA in Philadelphia A set list, or most commonly setlist, is typically a handwritten or printed document created as an ordered list of songs, jokes,[1] stories and other elements an artist intends to present during a specific performance. A list set can be made of almost any material that is writable or printed on it, but most are paper, cardboard or craftsman. They are also often laminated, especially for outdoor places. The set list is usually recorded on a stage that musicians can see, or to equipment such as monitors or amplifiers. Artists and groups use list sets for a variety of reasons beyond the mere order of performance events. They are often used to help create the overall mood of the collection by creating a

memorable sense of range and variety in tone, tempo and dynamism between songs. [2] [3] They are also used to create collections for specific audiences and locations. An increasingly common use is the use of technologies such as instant voting on social media and websites [4] where fans can choose what to do. Many performers also craft their playlists to highlight other elements of Shows, such as visual environment, dancing, or to refer to specific albums or phases of your career. [5] Music fans also refer to the list set in the non-physical sense of what a performance artist chooses to play. Many artists use the same list for each performance on a concert tour. Others prefer to make their lists different during a tour, whether it benefits fans who participate in numerous performances or to avoid a sense of co-ordance among musicians. The Grateful Dead was known for never playing the same setlist twice. Some of these artists have predetermined slots in an otherwise largely fixed show where different songs can be inserted. Some artists even say that the same song will not be played in two shows in a while; and still others, like Van Morrison, do not use any predetermined lists. The Depeche Laminated mode suite there are websites that track and report information about things like venue and bands on the bill of any date, as well as which band members were in attendance, copies of show posters and other memorabilia were available, and most importantly, the actual collection used for that particular event. This is done to provide a more accurate record of each individual show, which will later be used for the difference between performances during a tour, as many artists will change their collection list from one night to another. In the pre-smartphone era, devoted followers participating in concerts by popular artists such as Bruce Springsteen or Led Zeppelin, who have huge fan bases around the world, were often tasked with tracking which songs, and in what order, created their own handwritten version of the correct list set for the event to later be shared with other fans through fan clubs and other forums. Are. When early mobile phones became commonplaplast with the public, people began using text messaging to report songs played in real time to a friend or fellow fan who then updated a setlist running on one or more internet forums dedicated to the night performer. When internet-connected smartphones came about, fans began posting setlists directly to these forums and their websites, often as part of a running game commentary of their concert experiences on social media sites like MySpace and later Twitter. Collecting setlists has become almost as popular for music fans as collecting tickets and showing posters, with the actual physical collection becoming a valuable and uniquely rare memento for concert goers and music fans, in general, [7]. Fans often wait around after a concert just so they can perform one scene after one or so they can try asking one roadie or other event staff. The crew also occasionally keep items like original setlists, guitar picks, drums and other items used during a run as well or sell memorabilia at the market onwards On auction websites like eBay, where collectors, fans, and concert attendees who are looking to highlight their experience of a particular show can buy them for their collection. In some cases, it is so great an urge for a fan to get a setlist that they don't wait for a show to end before trying to get their hands on one.
