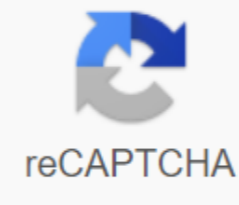

Agnates and cognates

AGNATE (Lat. agnatus). Agnates, in law and England and Scotland, for sons bound through the father as cognates are persons bound through the mother. In Roman law both these terms had a somewhat different mark.
