One adult was baptized on Feb.18th.

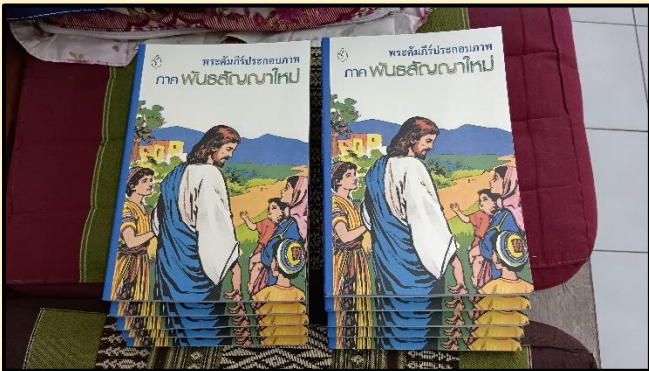


We gave out 10 baptism certificates.



We welcomed our new converts who were baptized.

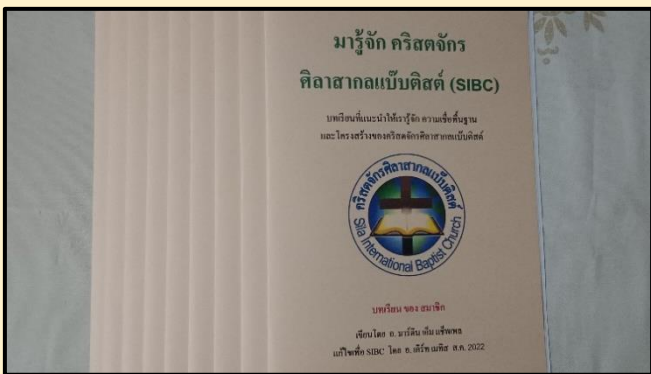
Following up & Encouraging.

He will read O.T. Bible after he has read N.T. Bible.



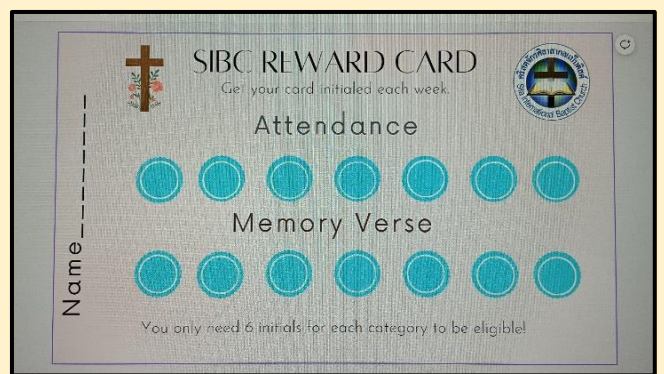
All 10 baptized will take SIBC membership class.

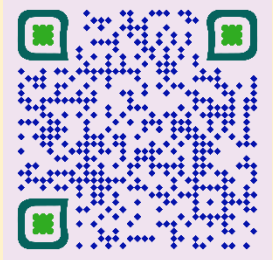


How to give to Thailand Missions
