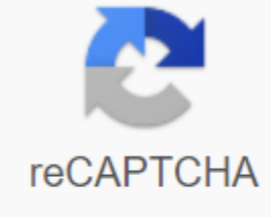

Start Google Chrome on your computer. Click on the menu icon (three points). Choose your settings. From the left glass, click to expand Advanced. Click on privacy security. Scroll down and click on the content settings. Scroll down again and click on the handlers. Under Handlers, switch switch include Allow sites to ask to become default handlers for protocols after that, resume the browser and check if you can open magnetic links directly. When you click on a magnetic link, either by sharing an email or provided by torrent sites, your web browsers like Chrome automatically determines the correct protocol and encourages you to open a link through your default torrent client, like uTorrent or BitTorrent. They are most commonly used to download torrents from the Internet, which is a popular way of sharing files. They are also known as the URL magnet. The reason they are so popular is because you can copy and paste these links into plain text almost anywhere like mail, text messages, and the web. This makes it easier to access files in the P2P environment. In addition, there is no need to store bittorrent files on the server. Why Magnet LinksMagnet links are safer and remove the need to hash individual files to protect them from cyberthreats. The .torrent file contains the tracker URL, the file names to be downloaded, and the hash code. The magnet link will essentially remove the middleman and connect you directly to the source using the hash code. Your torrent client will use this hash code to find peers who download the necessary files. There is no need to download a torrent file or even a tracker. This saves the bandwidth of the hosting site as well as users. It's a win-win situation. Once you click on the magnetic link, Chrome should be able to disassemble the hash data and open it in your default torrent client. The problem occurs when Chrome refuses to identify the magnetic link and returns the bug. You can't download files shared with friends and colleagues now. Since you're dealing with content here, let's see if the settings of your Chrome browser content are set correctly. Click on the menu icon in any Chrome tab and select Settings. Scroll to the bottom of the page to find the Advanced button. Click on it to reveal more options. The first headline should be privacy and security. Underneath it, you'll find content settings. You are looking for the Handlers option where you will allow sites to request to become default handlers for protocols (recommended). Click on it and make sure the option switches to. If so, you'll see it in blue, and if it's not, then it'll be gray out. Here you can enter a number of commands to help you manage your computer. We enter 'regedit' in the box. This will open the registry editor in the new window. Now you have to move on to HKEY_CLASSES_ROOT the next file location. You may have to scroll a lot here. In the right glass you will see a Data column that will show the full path of the BitTorrent client directory. Your job here is to make sure that the BitTorrent client is in the same directory that you see here. In my case, it should be here: UsersAppDataRoamingBitTorrent-BitTorrent.exe Notice .exe at the end? This means that it binds to the file you're leaving, which should be run when it needs to be. Ignore random lines of text after that. Now open the C drive in the new window and start the drilling process. Click Win'E to open my computer directly. If your torrent client is in another folder, you'll have to edit the registry entry under the Name column. Choose the default name and select Modify to be able to change the directory hierarchy that should refer to your torrent client's file (format.exe). Note that the random key line at the end should remain intact. That's where it's for a reason. You just have to change the structure of the folder and save.
