



Proverbs 22:4 By humility and the fear of the LORD are riches, and honour, and life.


Key to success is the fear of the Lord - Ecclesiastes 5:7 For in the multitude of dreams there are vanities, as well as in many words: but you must fear God.

## Last Month of 2022 Thank God for A Great Year



We started 2022 with uncertainty. The PPCOC building was due to demolished and we had to pre-record our worship for 3 Sundays as we awaited approval for the registration of our church with the authorities.

By February, after more than a month, we received approval for our registration and were able to rent a meeting place near an MRT station.

It took us a few weeks to renovate the rented premises. It was a relief to secure a place and not just rent a hall on an hourly basis. We did not have to worry about moving furniture, and have a place we can use during the week.

On the 6th March, we had our first worship in the new location. What a joy it was to have a place of our own after moving around between 3 other venues.



With a new location, it was time to modify our logo from a house church to a growing church coming out into the community (above) while retaining its original simplicity in design. The Household of Faith was now ready for a new start. After 3 weeks, Care teams resumed. As the children have grown, a youth Care team was started besides the men's and ladies' care teams.

It was observed that it took a while for the membership to return in full strength, but by our 5th Anniversary, most had returned.

Visitors are now joining us every week as well as supporters, SIBI students and overseas visitors.



We had a good turn out at Missions Sunday with brother Ong Kok Bin as our guest speaker.


With only a month left in 2022, we are thankful to the Lord, members and supporters for a great year. We look forward to all kinds of possibilities in the coming year, with God's grace.






### 1. Build Friendships

Proverbs 18:24

A man that hath friends must show himself friendly: and there is a friend that sticks closer than a brother.

Start by counting the number of your friends.

Then see how many you are keeping touch.

Some people have over a thousand friends on Facebook – but they do not mean anything.

More than just friends - how many are you keeping in touch, and how many you can call for help?

These are more special than a brother.

Friendliness is a two-way street.



Let us focus on the Jews at the time of Christ:

- Taken into captivity
- Returned to a small portion of land Temple only a shadow of what it was

- In their recent 400 years:
   No divine intervention
   Religion was legalistic and political
  - Greek king Antiochus IV marched into the
  - Jewish temple and sacrificed a pig
     Rebel warriors Maccabees secured 100 years independence Hanukkah
  - General Pompey brought it under Roman rule

Luke 1:13-19

But the angel said to him, "Don't be afraid, Zacharias... your wife, Elizabeth, will bear you a son, and you shall call his name John. You will have joy and gladness...

He will turn many of the children of Israel to the Lord, their God...

The angel answered him, "I am Gabriel, who stands in the presence of God. I was sent to speak to you, and to bring you this good news.



### Conclusion
