This Sunday

18th Sunday after Pentecost - It is so easy and so tempting to build ourselves up at the expense of others. "*I can't imagine ever doing that*." "*How can people live like that*?" "*Who would do such a thing*?" At some point we all think or say these sorts of things. Like it or not, we use these words to comfort ourselves at the expense of others. These words are a reminder that all people stand in need of God's grace. Each of this day's readings shows us this reality: Ezekiel proclaims God's invitation, "*Turn, then, and live*" (*Ezek. 18:32*). This is an invitation that extends to all people, from a God deeply desiring a loving and life-giving relationship with humanity. In Philippians, we are reminded of Jesus' act of grace on the cross, emptying himself, becoming sin so that all creation might be redeemed through him. And in the gospel, in the parable of the two sons, Jesus invites us to choose between two sons when neither fully does the will of their father. Here Jesus makes the point that we are all equally in need of God's grace. All of us are in need of God's grace; God extends grace to all, and one day we will confess that salvation as one people.

A Spiritual Practice for this Week - Look for an empty jar, box, or container to use as a prayer focus this week. Listen for God's voice to you in Philippians 2:1-13, considering how the Spirit might be inviting you to empty yourself in this season of your life, not as punishment, but to "let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus."

Gospel Service Today - This Sunday we sing many traditional "gospel songs" at worship. The roots of American gospel singing lie in the spiritual songs of the eighteenth-century religious awakenings and African American spirituals. We will sing and hear gospel songs from both traditions this morning.

Sunday School - The kids had fun learning about Noah's Ark and creating rainbows on their activity sheets. They learned Noah had a hard job to do from God and followed His word to save so many animals. Join us after Children's Word during service!
