**NOTES**

**Walk details, bus/train times can change after we go to print – PLEASE CHECK BEFORE YOU SET OUT.**

**Please remember that all walkers take part at their own risk and that they are responsible for their own safety.**

Bring food and drink. Make sure you have a sufficient supply of liquid to avoid dehydration. Boots are recommended on all rambles. Have adequate rainwear.

Every walker is asked to carry details of whom to contact in case of emergency, also any relevant details of medication.

Car sharing – passengers are asked to contribute £2 per shorter journey towards costs. If the round trip is in excess of 30 miles, please contribute £3.

Please allow the leader to lead and don't get ahead. Try to keep together as a group.

Walkers are requested **not** to bring dogs on walks.

Anyone wishing to leave the walk early must inform the leader before doing so.

The annual membership subscription is currently £5 per annum; our financial year starts on January 1<sup>st</sup>.

In the event of an alteration to the published programme, including cancellation due to bad weather, we will do our best to contact you, but this cannot be guaranteed.

The HF Sheffield Group Committee holds contact details of members in order to communicate with them with regard to organisational issues within the Sheffield group, and to keep them informed of events taking place.
