



It is time to turn our attention to our annual Missions Sunday - coming on 13th December 2020 when I will share a Missions sermon. The Household of Faith was born out of our passion for missions and sharing the word of God.

Currently, our Missions Fund stands at \$22,660 and we look forward to increasing this on Missions Sunday this year. Like everything we do at the Household of Faith, contribution to our Missions Fund is freewill.

This year has been a difficult year for many, with some facing financial struggles due to the pandemic. God is good, has preserved our health and even enabled us to reach out to more people througth live streaming.

We are thankful for our faith and well-being, and are blessed with the opportunity to pass it on during Missions Sunday.

#### **Patience**

Colossians 1:11 - We are "strengthened with all power according to His glorious might so that we may have great endurance and patience..."

### Sermons for the Rest of the Year (Past Sermon Videos are on our Website)



Although we were not able to assemble during most of 2020, and it is unlikely that we will be able to do so any time soon, we were able to keep on worship and listen to sermons uninterrupted, throughout the year.

When the Metropolitan YMCA was not available, we live streamed from the home of the Alfred Poons for several weeks until the number of worshippers permitted was reduced to 5.

We then moved the live stream to my office at the Church of Christ, Pasir Panjang. During the Curcuit Breaker period, the number was further reduced to allow only a bare bones crew, so I carried out the entire broadcast - from call to worship, scripture reading and opening prayer to presiding over the Lord's Supper, collection, sermon to announcements and closing prayer with technical assistance for the broadcast.

We are now allowed up to 10 persons, but my office can only accommodate 9 persons due to the safe distancing regulations. We are happy to have a regular team comprising members like Paul Quek, Paul Poon, Alfred, with Andy and Eric joining us from time to time.

#### **Faithfulness**

Faithfulness = dependability + trust

Isaiah 25:1 - O Lord, you are my God; I will exalt you and praise your name; for in perfect faithfulness you have done marvelous things; things planned long ago

Ephesians 3:16-17 - I pray that out of His glorious riches He may strengthen you with power through His Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith

2 Thessalonians 1:11 - With this in mind, we constantly pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of his calling, and that by his power he may bring to fruition your every desire for goodness and your every deed prompted by faith.

#### **Gentleness/ Meekness**

Meekness = Baker's Evangelical Bible Dictionary explains, "Meekness does not identify the weak but more precisely the strong who have been placed in a position of weakness where they persevere without giving up e.g. animals that are tarmed

Matthew 11:29 Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am **gentle and humble** in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

Numbers 12:3 Now the man Moses was very **humble**, above all the men who were on the surface of the earth.

Ephesians 4:2 Be completely humble and **gentle**; be patient, bearing with one another in love.

#### **Self-control**

Self-control is the opposite of the works of the flesh that indulge in sensual desires

Ability to control one's body and its sensual appetites and desires – particularly moderation in eating and drinking

Galatians 5:16 - So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh

2 Peter 1:5-7 - But also for this very reason, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue, to virtue knowledge, to knowledge self-control, to self-control perseverance, to perseverance godliness, to godliness brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness love

- **3. Provide** willingly, cheerfully and bountifully 2 Corinthians 9:7 Let each man give according as he has determined in his heart; not grudgingly, or under compulsion; for God loves a cheerful giver.

On December 20th, I will discuss the Keeping of Days and how we can use the festive season to reach out for the Lord instead of dismissing it for its pagan roots.

Romans 14:5-6 One man esteems one day as more important. Another esteems every day alike. Let each man be fully assured in his own mind. He who observes the day, observes it to the Lord; and he who does not observe the day, to the Lord he does not observe it. He who eats, eats to the Lord, for he gives God thanks. He who doesn't eat, to the Lord he doesn't eat, and gives God thanks.



My final sermon for the year is one on Thanksgiving. With the pandemic and its accompanying gloom and doom, God is still in charge and there are so many things to be thankful for. The best reason of course is that we are able to read this - alive and kicking!

Colossians 3:15-17 "And be thankful. Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts. And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him."



#### 22nd November 2020



We have committed 3 weeks this November to the study of the Fruit of the Spirit. In contrast to what we see around us in this world, Christians are to live in the Spirit and exemplify the fruit thereof.

We read in Galatians 5:22-23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and selfcontrol. Against such things there is no law.

#### **Works of the Flesh**

To fully understand the fruit of the Spirit, we must first contrast it with the works of the flesh. The Bible lists these in a few verses before listing the fruit of the Spirit.

Galatians 5:19-21 Now the works of the flesh are obvious, which are: adultery, sexual immorality, uncleanness, lustfulness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, strife, jealousies, outbursts of anger, rivalries, divisions, heresies, envyings, murders, drunkenness, orgies, and things like these; of which I forewarn you, even as I also forewarned you, that those who practice such things will not inherit the Kingdom of God.

To make it very clear, the Bible concludes this list by saying that those who practice such things will not inherit the Kingdom of God.

On the other hand, those who produce the fruit of the Spirit will find, that against such things there is no law. This means that those who practice these spiritual traits are obeying the Law. They fulfill the Law without even thinking about it at times, because the fruit of the Spirit comes out of their lives naturally, so they are not doing it to satisfy a legal imperative.

Let us sum up the fruit of the Spirit in 3 categories of three.

#### Love, Joy, Peace

The first 3 qualities that adorn a person living in the Spirit are love, joy and peace. These are the characteristics of a contented person because these are inner qualities of the heart. Jesus says in Matthew 15:19-20 For out of the heart come forth evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, sexual sins, thefts, false testimony, and blasphemies. These are the things which defile the man; but to eat with unwashed hands doesn't defile the man.

#### Patience, Kindness, Goodness

The next 3 qualities that adorn a person living in the Spirit are patience, kindness and goodness. These are the characteristics of a caring person because of the actions that we bestow on one another.

The Household of Faith recently completed a short series on "One Another". Fifty-nine times in the New Testament, we are exhorted to intentionally look away from our own needs and to care for one another.

Galatians 6:2 puts it so clearly - Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

#### Faithfulness, Gentleness, Self-control

The last 3 qualities that adorn a person living in the Spirit are faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. These are the characteristics of a devout person because these are spiritual qualities that we offer to God.

Guests from 3 countries graced the occasion - Malaysia, Indonesia and China.










First Annual Missions Sunday in session at the Metropolitan YMCA at the Cassia conference room.



Adam and Eve, Cain

By Genesis 6 - Genesis 6:5 Yahweh saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.

Today's world has advanced, but sin is still a problem e.g. Computer viruses






