Project INSPIRE has resulted in a 100% increase in the research publication rate, a milestone achievement that underscores the project's success in elevating student research to an internationally recognized level. This significant improvement has not only enhanced the school's academic reputation but has also provided students with invaluable opportunities to engage with global scientific communities. To conclude, partnership with INSTABRIGHT International Guild of Researchers and Educators (E-GAZETTE) made the way of addressing and attaining the objectives of Project INSPIRE. Thirty-nine research (39) of two hundred twenty-nine (229) students were published international.
