As part of its Festival Celebrations for 2019, the Province of Shropshire has seen a 'Walking Maul' travel (on foot) between each of our 35 Lodges, and it has been presented (and used) in each of these Lodges. The last such meeting was the Consecration of our Provincial Grand Stewards' Lodge just over a week ago. Our Festival – in aid of the Grand Charity/MCF – ends on October 26th.

While many Brethren have walked varying distances in support of this initiative, the lead walker has been WBro Roger Michell of Sabrina Lodge 4158. This summer he (and his wife Linda) will walk the final leg of the planned journey by travelling from Shrewsbury to London on foot, starting on 27th May and ending on 11th June. They will generally follow a route along the Severn Way, the Gloucestershire Way, the Oxfordshire Way, thence along the Thames Path to London. His detailed itinerary is below, and ends with the presentation of the Walking Maul at the meeting of United Grand Lodge on 12th June.

There are two main purposes in sending this to the Provinces through which Roger and Linda will pass: firstly, we hope that your Provincial Communication Officers will be able to inform their Provinces of Roger's itinerary, so that Masons near you may choose to join him for a portion of the walk. Secondly – and perhaps most importantly – Roger and Linda would also welcome offers of accommodation at the end of days 3, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 (the places he will reach at the end of each day are shown under "Arr."). Their needs are few and their appetites small, but if Brethren in your Provinces could offer a bed for the night, a small breakfast in the morning and arrange transfer (if required) to and from the walking route, this would be most welcome. A key requirement for much of the route is also someone to transfer their modest luggage to their next destination. THE "LAST GASP"

After walks totalling 823 miles linking all 35 lodges in the Province of Shropshire, the last leg of the Provincial Perambulations – from Shrewsbury to London – will take place between **Monday 27**th **May and Tuesday 11**th **June**, **2019**. The selected route follows the Severn Way to Tewkesbury, the Gloucestershire Way to Bledington, the Oxfordshire Way to Henley and finally the Thames Path to London. On **Wednesday**, **12**th **June** the Walking Maul will be presented at the **Quarterly Communication of UGLE** by the RWPrGM. The 237 mile trek detailed below will bring the cumulative total walked to 1058 miles in celebration of the Shropshire 2019 Festival for the Grand Charity.
