The Apostle Paul preached to the people of Athens of the first century: God, who made peace, and everything in it, being the Lord of heaven and earth, does not live in made by man, and he did not serve with human hands, as if he needed something, as he himself gives all mankind life, breath and all that. And he made of one man every people of humanity to live on the entire face of the earth, defining the allotted periods and boundaries of their dwelling that they should seek God, in the hope that they can feel their way to him and find him. However, he is not really far from each of us, for in it we live and move and our being; as even some of your own poets said: For we are indeed his offspring. (Acts 17:24-28) Paul preached a lot, from Jerusalem to Rome. But most of all he is remembered for what he wrote - thirteen books about what we call the New Testament of the Bible. There

is a God. He's alive. The word of the Lord's heavens were made, and by the breath of his mouth all their master (Dog 33:6), but he also provided a written revelation to all mankind-the means by which we can know him, follow him, and eventually live with him after death. One way to understand the Bible is to remember that B.I.B.L.E. means Basic Instructions Before You Leave Earth. I know 99% of adults need to know that this doesn't really mean that. It is used only as a mnemonic device to explain that thousands of pages of the Spirit's work from which we draw the truth of God. That's nice. But it doesn't make any sense. The one that comes with your phone. Even driving a car is complicated. In his letter to Jewish Christians, Paul said, Let us go beyond the basic teachings of Christ and be advanced to maturity. While basic, elementary teachings that are easy to understand are at the heart of the gospel, the Bible as a whole is all of great importance surrounding Good News. The Bible contains basic instructions, but not everything in the Bible is a simple starting point for faith. The Old Testament is basically history, much of the rest of poetry and prophecy, with a small faction containing directions, laws or guidance, and even much of this is not directly for Christians, but for Israelites under the Old Testament. The Four Gospels are a biography mixed with the sermons, illustrations, and commandments of Jesus. The letters that follow contain many instructions, but also other forms of communication. To whom The collection of works the instruction itself is to dismiss the function of huge pieces of scripture. I wouldn't give the Bible to anyone and say, Make sure you read this before you leave the planet. Like, are the aliens coming? What if I die first? How about we lead our whole lives as Christians? Where does the Bible say that her own instructions are only for after life? Isn't the kingdom here and now? The phrase may leave open the idea that the earth is nothing more than garbage and we get on a plane somewhere else. But the instructions in the Bible cannot be read without applying them here and now, not just packing bags and plans to make for the trip later, but plans on how to turn this world into a here and now. The Bible comes from the Greek word, which means books. And these books in themselves, woven into a beautiful and harmonious library, give us a number of names that we can call them, including The Scriptures (what is written) and the Gospel (good news)! To me, good news always sounds better than basic instructions. If you gave me a choice between a positive and exciting newspaper article and a set of instructions, I'd most likely respond to the news. This does not mean that the Bible is simply news without calling for an obedient answer, but when God speaks, we do injustice by simply calling the full collection of its great history the basic instructions. The Bible contains a powerful history of God to whom we must obey. But the Bible is not an instruction. There's no need for a banal acronym when we have so many other options like Good News to explain what the word is for us. The instruction is that people tend to read once, if at all, and if they read it more than once, it is only when something goes wrong. I don't want to give the impression that word is something to be a look at once and only go back to when there is a problem. I want to exemplifies the word dwelling in me richly. Maybe we should start calling it GNAHWCTE: Good news about who came to Earth. Earth.
