Built from brick under traditional thatch, the chalets blend naturally with their surroundings while framing sweeping views of the Amphitheatre and Tugela Falls — the world's second-highest waterfall. Days here begin with mist drifting through valleys and end beside glowing fireplaces as the sun fades over the cliffs.

Accommodation

2-Sleeper Chalets:

- Lower Camp: Open-plan bedroom and living area, separate kitchen and bathroom.
- Upper Camp: Separate bedroom, lounge, kitchen, and bathroom.

4-Sleeper Chalets:

- Lower Camp: Two bedrooms, open-plan living area, separate kitchen, and bathroom.
- Upper Camp: Open-plan kitchen and lounge, two bedrooms, bathroom with walk-in shower.

At a Glance

- Capacity: Up to 94 guests
- Units: 29 (chalets, cottages, and lodge)
- Power: 24-hour electricity (220V)
- Shop: None – bring all provisions
- Wi-Fi: None – digital detox guaranteed
- Heating / Cooling: Fans and electric heaters (no air-conditioning)
- Pool / Laundry: Not available
- Children: Welcome
- Fenced: No – wildlife such as bushbuck and baboons may wander nearby

Good to Know

- Self-catering only – no restaurant on-site.
- Limited 3G reception; signal strongest near Upper Camp.
- Fireplaces in selected units – purchase firewood inside the park.
- Closest town: Bergville (44 km).
- Park gates close 18:00 (Mar-Oct) / 19:00 (Nov-Feb).

All units include kitchens for self-catering, fireplaces or heaters for winter comfort, and verandas that open to spectacular scenery. (Note: Firewood cannot be brought into the Park due to the Polyphagous Shot Hole Borer beetle — wood can be purchased locally.)
