
Filling in the Membership Application Form

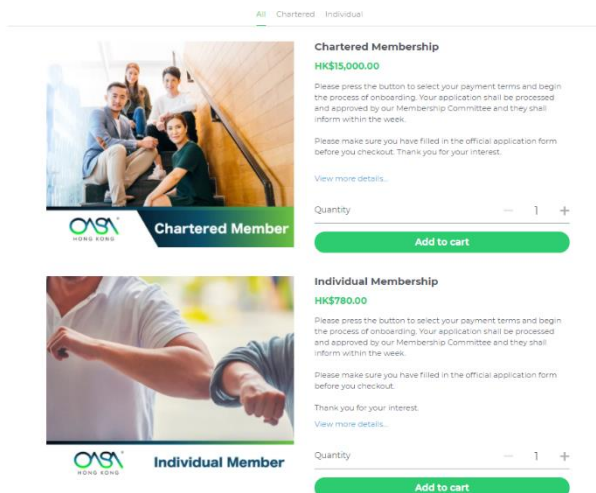
Step 2: Download and Please Read the Code of Conduct and the Terms and Conditions of Membership

Step 3: Choose Your Membership Type

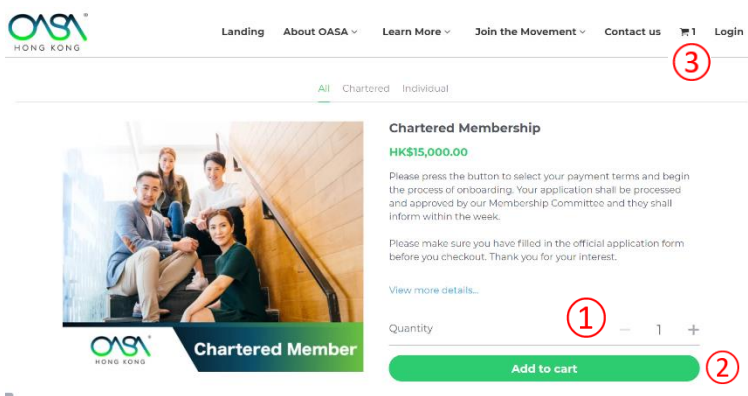
3.1: Select membership type in <https://www.oasahk.org/membership> (Chartered Membership/ Individual Membership/Student Membership)

New categories of membership shall be added in 2021.




3.2: Set Quantity to “1” and click “Add to Cart”.

3.3: Please tick the checkbox and press “CHECKOUT”.




3.4: Select payment method.
