By Diana Braun's iPod is a portable media player, most music for music, manufactured by Apple Inc. The product line includes the classic iPod, iPod Shuffle, iPod Nano and Touch iPod. Songs can be purchased, downloaded and created through playlists on your computer using iTunes, available for free on the internet Apple.com. The playlists can then be uploaded and added to your iPod by manually syncing your iPod devices with iTunes. Connect your iPod to your computer using the supplied USB cable. The iTunes program will automatically launch. If iTunes is not launched, click the Start button, then click All Programs and click iTunes in the applications list. Click the iPod icon under Devices in the left pane of the iTunes pane. Select the Summary tab from the main section of the iTunes pane. Click the check box next to Manually Manage Music and Video or Manually Manage Music to select this option. This will disable the automatic sync settings for the music, TV shows and movies tabs. Select the playlist from the left of the iTunes window under Playlists and drag it onto your iPod (iPod icon located under Device). Select your iPod under Device and click the Eject icon next to it to properly dispel your iPod from your computer. There's a great mixture of Christmas songs instrumental and professionally available. Visit the Free Christmas music page. If you do a general search, the paid music shows results are available. Choose a song you are interested in. You are pushing to save the song file to your computer. If players are singing in the browser, right-click a blank area of the page and use the Save As option to download it. ChristmasGifts.com have a great selection of contemporary, traditional, and classic holiday songs. Most songs are instrumental. Still, there are also professional selections. Plus, you'll find several unique spoof songs that can add some fun and a smile to your day. If you're part of a group that carols during the holidays, check out this freebie out. iTunes auf Deutsch! Downloading German Music—Legally Would You Like to Explore the World of Modern German Music? Would you like to download rock, pop, or rap songs in German? How about watching a German music video online? Well, I just did all that, and little boy was reading fun! Apple must listen to United States complaints to fans of German music, who for a long time could only get a tantalized look at, and even listen to, songs and albums by German (and Austria) artists, but couldn't buy any of it from Apple's American Music Store iTunes. This frustration has now disappeared for Mac and Windows users, but not entirely. A recent visit to the U. S. Music Store iTunes was an pleasant surprise. I found music and lyrics in German by many contemporary and traditional bands and artists from Austria, Germany, and German Switzerland. And I could buy what I saw/heard! There were albums and songs by DIE PRINZEN, FALCO, HERBERT GRÖNEMEYER, THE PUHDYS, MÜNCHNER FREIHEIT, and even HEINO. (You'll also find audiobooks in German, language courses, and German comedy recordings available for download.) I discovered just about every kind of German music—from classical to breach, from Christmas to land-west—ready to listen to and buy. Soon I've downloaded (and paid for) an electric mix from Deutschland by DIE PRINZEN Ring a foil (think Johnny Cash) by Austrian WOLFGANG AMBROS. As I type the words, my computer is playing music by RAMMSTEIN (America, UDO LINDENBERG (Ich habe there is no nine Koffer in Berlin), and interesting Belgium band SCALA > KOLACNY BROTHERS (Schrei na Liebe) - All downloaded from the American iTunes Music Store. Mac or Windows users can then create CDs with the German songs downloaded or any mixture they want. If I had an iPod, I could also transfer these songs into it and listen wherever I go. A few more Surprises – Good and badalthough residents of Germany and Austria can download iTunes music from just about any German recording artist there, we American residents have to be content with slimmer piking. If you want to download songs by Die Fantastischen Vier, Rosenstolz, or Die Ärzte, (Die Bestend Band der Welt) you will be required in Germany. You can easily switch to the German music iTunes store and listen to songs by these artists, but when you try downloading a song or album, American farmers get this outstanding message: Your account is valid for songs from the U.S. iTunes Store. But at least you can listen to 30-second samples of the German songs. Even for the German artists who get to shop at the U.S., not all the albums or songs by this artist can offer. Some albums are partial, with only some selected songs available from iTunes, but that is also true to the normal American or artists. However, what has a lot better than what was available earlier (pretty much nothing). There is no German Songs menu section in the iTunes U.S. store (there is a German pop category, but you'll need help finding it; see Part 2 tips), so I started with a search by the artist's name or a song title. Sometimes I just type in a common German word (lies, freiheit) to see what results would pop up. As I explored the German offerings and this method in the U.S. store, I stumbled upon interesting things I can't find otherwise. Schrei Nach Liebe is a good example. Turns out the iTunes version I downloaded is a cover version by a Belgian chorus in which Ärzte songs, and the Germans are raving about how the medies took a metallic song (they also made Engel by Rammstein) and turned it into something very different but still cool. After uploading America by Rammstein, I discovered that it's in the German top 10 charts (Oct. 2004) and that iTunes has a music video version! (Free and in stunning quality with a high speed connection!)
