Main course - 4 Year 6 Months 2. Internship : 1 year (unpaid) The main course lasting 4 years 6 months is divided into three professional exams, 18 months each. Internships will be mandatory for students who have passed the B.U.M.S. final professor They will do their rotator internship duty in the hospital for 12 months. Degree to be awarded: Students who passed their B.U.M.S. final professor exam and completed a 12 month rotator internship at the hospital must be awarded a degree by Kamil-i-Tib-o-Jarahat (B.U.M.S.)
