**4. TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION:**

One letter must be from a current high school teacher or coach. The other letter can be from a current or former teacher and or coach. Both letters should explain why this person believes you are a strong candidate to receive the Steve Case Memorial Scholarship.

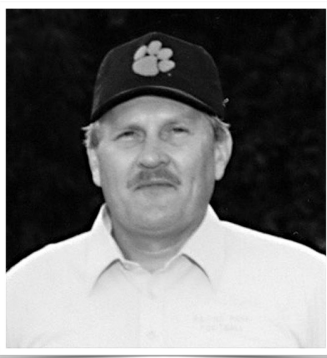
