Learning The Words of View Words are an essential part of learning to read. Unlike most words, they are generally not decoded. However, due to their high frequency, meeting sight words while reading is inevitable. There are many ways to learn and practice words on sight. While flash maps, worksheets and sight word activities all play an important role, the practice of sight words in the context of reading is essential to building the mastery of words in sight. Sentences of words in sight In order to encourage confidence in reading, I recommend using controlled text when practicing reading words of view in context. Controlled text means that through advance learning and image cues, students should be able to read all the words in the text. I created these viewword activities for all of Fry's first 300 words of view. Even if you don't use Fry's sight word lists, many words overlap with other lists. Most importantly, children will often encounter all these words when they learn to read! Using worksheets sight word sentences Here's how I use these viewword worksheets with my students. Identify the target word View The target word is always listed in the top left corner of the page. After discussing the word, we decide whether we will highlight, color, circle or emphasize the word. My students like to highlight with a pencil, but you can use a pencil, pen, or marker. It's up to you! I usually make them find the word of view in each sentence independently. Review image clues This is completely optional, but I like to review image clues with my students, especially my ELL/ESL students. We discuss the word we think the image represents and find the word in the sentence. Not only does this frontloading increase students' vocabulary, but it also helps them feel confident and succeed when it's time to read sentences! Read the sentences Now it starts! For the first reading, we usually read the word sentences aloud together. I like to make sure I model how to read sentences fluently and encourage the follow-up of words with my finger. Students a happy face once every sentence on the page was read. Repeated readings Let's build this ease! It's not enough to read the page once. Students should be exposed to repeated readings in order to develop mastery of word (and vision) Students must read the entire page at least three times (hence three smileys at the bottom). Don't worry, we're making it fun! They should be able to recognize them immediately. The practice of these words in the context of reading is what will lead to their mastery. That's why I created these view word cards with sentences. Above is a list of the 50 view words I made from sentence cards for. They are perfect for individual work, small groups, central work, or for practicing high-frequency words at home. The PDF file is in letter paper format. Each sheet has 2 cards. Print out the leaves and cut the cards. Laminate these cards for durability. I recommend printing these on the card stock or a thick paper so that they can last you longer. Each card has the word of view featured at the top in large font. Then there is a sentence with the word of view emphasized and bold. Each also includes a simple image that matches the sentence. I tried to keep the sentences as simple as possible. Find, one, has, have, look and, blue are some of the words that appear frequently while reading books. A child should see a high-frequency word and be able to say it without a second thought. There are many ways to learn and practice words on sight. I have designed board games, activities, worksheets and other resources to practice these words. Since sight words frequently appear during reading, it is important for our little learners to recognize them A word of view may or may not be decodable.
