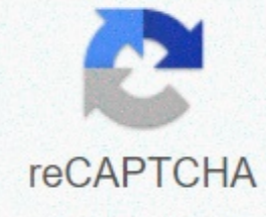

A time of austerity; In ancient times, during the period before the Winter Solstice, the people of Kamit underwent a process of purification with the aim of advancing the goal of achieving their divinity. These people, our ancestors, devoted themselves to the symbolic practice of the festival of the search for Ausar. It was the ritual exercises associated with these practices that culminated in the Utchau Metu (Weighing Ceremony of the Heart and Words) intended for the realization of divinity during the Winter Solstice. Austerities mark the period of purification by denying the desires of the person (the lower self) to empower the Higher Being. The process helps focus the Initiate on his divinity by addressing specific entertainment and dietary conditioning.
