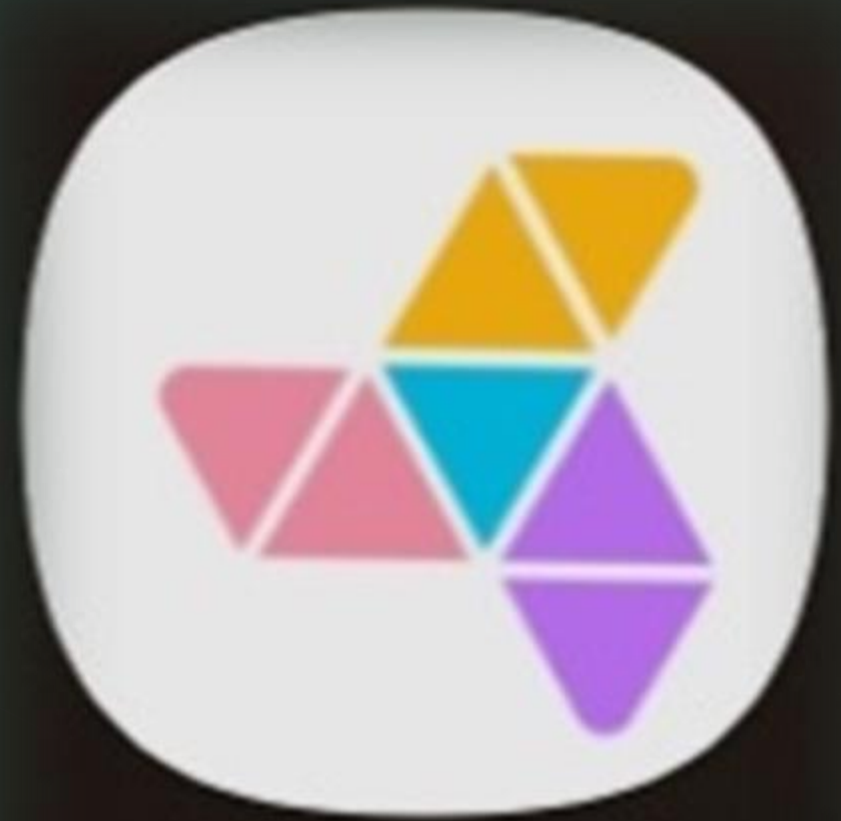

Policies to remember

Health and safety is a shared responsibility

- If you notice that your child is unwell with flu symptoms (such as green discharge from the nose), we kindly ask that you keep your child at home to help prevent the spread of illness.
- If your child has experienced a fever in the past 24 hours, we would appreciate it if you could keep them at home until they have fully recovered.
- Should your doctor diagnose your child with a contagious illness such as hand, foot, and mouth disease, chickenpox, measles, or mumps, please be so kind as to inform the nursery. This will allow us to thoroughly sanitize the environment before other children use any shared materials.



Policies to remember

Healthy eating starts from home

- To ensure the health and safety of all children, we kindly ask that no nuts, chocolate, or junk food be brought to the nursery.
- We would greatly appreciate it if you could send healthy lunch boxes with fruits, vegetables, sandwiches, salads, pasta, or rice.
- We respectfully request that you avoid sending junk food such as chips, juices, chocolates, nuts, or nut butters, as these items will not be opened or served to your child.
- Please do let us know of any allergies or health requirements when you enroll your child so we can provide the best care possible.

EYFS Curriculum

The Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) framework outlines seven areas of learning and development. These are divided into three prime areas and four specific areas.

The prime areas are Communication and Language, Physical Development, and Personal, Social and Emotional Development.

The specific areas are Literacy, Mathematics, Understanding the World, and Expressive Arts and Design.



Prime Areas

Prime Areas:

Communication and Language:

This area focuses on developing children's ability to express themselves, understand others, and build strong communication skills through listening, attention, and speaking.

Physical Development:

This area promotes children's physical health and well-being, including gross and fine motor skills, coordination, and self-care skills.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED):

This area supports children's self-awareness, self-regulation, managing feelings, building relationships, and developing a positive sense of self.



Specific Areas

Literacy:

This area focuses on developing children's early reading and writing skills, including phonics, comprehension, and a love of books.

Mathematics:

This area helps children develop an understanding of numbers, shapes, measures, and patterns.

Understanding the World:

This area encourages children to make sense of their physical world and their community, including their cultures and beliefs.

Expressive Arts and Design:

This area fosters children's creativity and self-expression through various art forms, including music, movement, and design.

These seven areas are interconnected, with skills in the prime areas supporting children's learning and development in the specific areas, according to the EYFS framework.





Assessments & Observations

- At the end of each term (December, March, and June), assessments are shared with parents via the app. These include a checklist of developmental milestones and teacher comments on your child's progress.
- A summary of your child's learning journey and classroom performance is also provided through the app at the same time.



Developmental delays

- We are equipped/experienced to manage and handle differentiated learning and developmental delays.
- In case we find out your child is going through any specific delays we make our observations, consult parents and discuss our observations so that important measures can be taken to overcome these delays as a team
- We do provide speech therapy and OT at the nursery in partnership with special education institutes when/if needed



Frequently asked question

- How many months is a term?

The academic year consist of 3 terms (Sept – Dec, Jan to March, April to June) July and August we do summer camp

- Can we pay fee on a monthly basis?

Yes you can, but please understand that it is a full term/year commitment paid in monthly installments (provided as a favour by the nursery). In case you leave in between or go on holidays the payment has to be made for the whole term. (School leaving certificate is only issued after clearing all dues)

- Can my child attend without unifrom in home attire?

No, please note that the nursery has a sense of discipline and dress up protocol which ahs to be followed according to KHDA guidelines. All parents are requested to send children in complete unifrom

- What do I need to send in my child's bag?

Snack, Water, lunch, diapers (if applicable), wipes, change of clothes

- Is your currcisulum accepted in schools?

Yes! Our curriculum is accepted in all schools. We are KHDA registered and regulated hence your child will receive a proper school leaving certificate from the nursery after completing the academic year with us.
