

exe) Every time I place a ad at the center in the column my banner rotates to the left, as if it was sent left to right. Why is this happening? A: I've found that the image must have the exact same width as the column. The column width should be set to be 100%. If that's set to, say 250px, and the banner image has a width of 200px, then it looks weird. If the column width is set to 75%, then the banner should have a width of 100% and the column width set to 75% for the content. When you set it to be the same width, it behaves like you wanted it to. Hope this helps! Little is known about the origins and function of matrix vesicles. Matrix vesicles are vesicular bodies present in cartilage matrix (see, e.g., Pohley et al. (1983) "The origin of articular cartilage matrix vesicles and their function in endochondral ossification", *Biochim. Biophys. Acta* 708: 185-192). They are suggested to arise as the result of budding or blebbing of the plasma membrane of chondrocytes, or chondroprogenitor cells, and to detach from the cell surface. The function of matrix vesicles is not understood, and it is unclear whether they are capable of transport. Nevertheless, the hypothesis that matrix vesicles are precursors to clasts is based on an extensive body of indirect evidence. In view of the foregoing, there is a need in the art for a process of isolating and purifying matrix vesicles for further study, and for the discovery of additional matrix vesicles.
