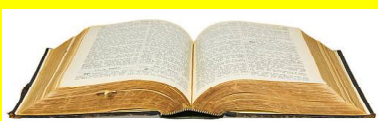

- 4 The next time you return to your prayer journal, if you are reminded of a scripture, fill this portion. This is optional, but it will give substance to your prayer.
- 5 Enhance your petition with praise and thanks as you recognize how God is answering your prayers. Not every prayer is answered overnight.

When your prayer is answered (eg “Good results on my mother’s medical checkup”, put a tick ✓ mark right around the top corner where you see the □ .

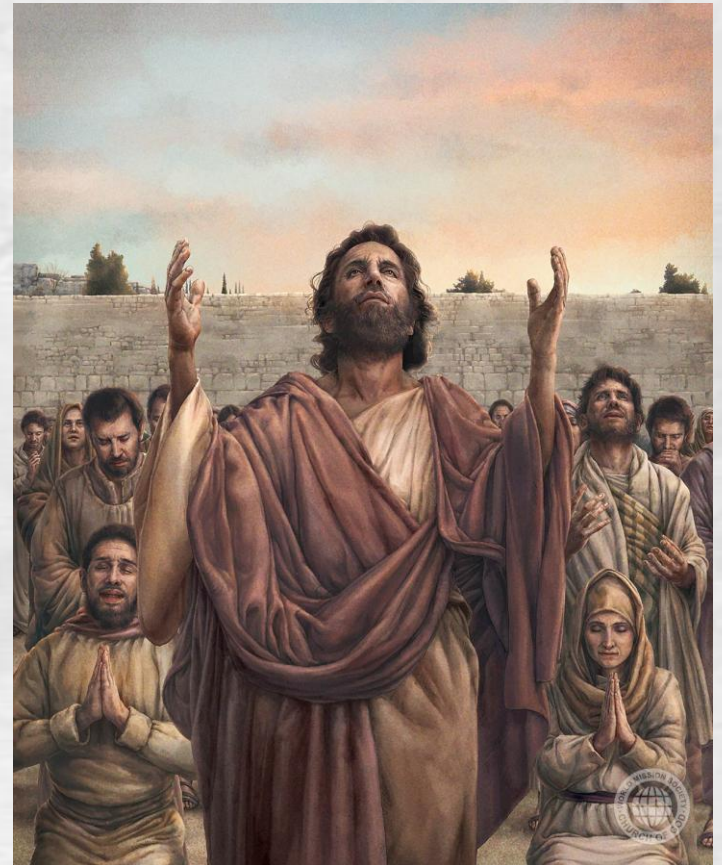

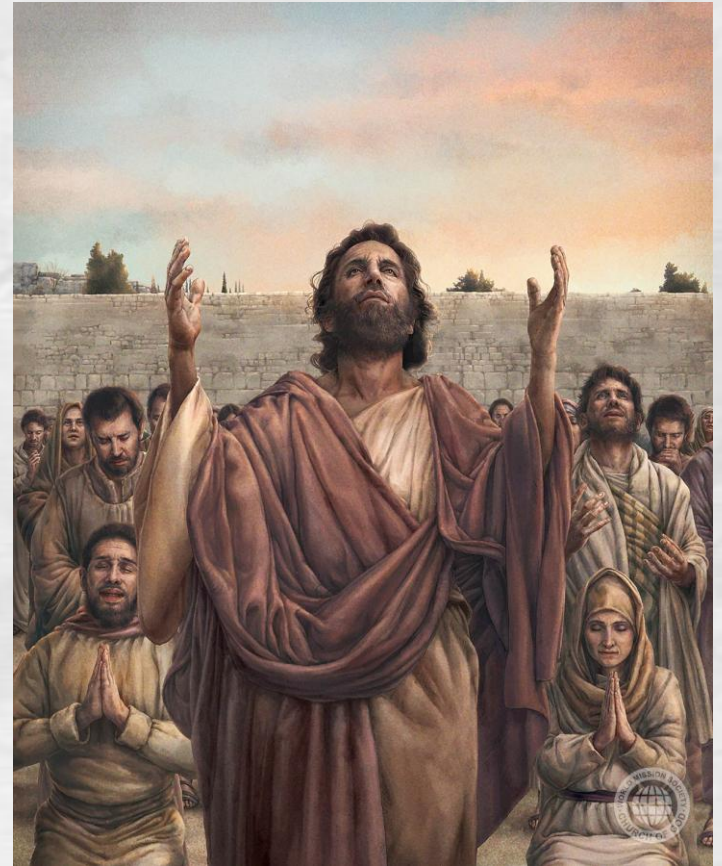
Context

- **Story of King Jehoshaphat:**
2 Chronicles 20:1-26 (ESV)
- Story of **victory through faith**
and worship rather than warfare.



Context

- **Jehoshaphat** was the **king of Judah** (southern kingdom), descendant of David, and **ancestor** of Jesus (Matt 1:8).
- Ruled around **873–849 B.C.**
- Known as a **righteous king** who sought to follow the Lord.
- Judah was **surrounded by hostile neighbors: Moab, Ammon** (descendants of Lot daughters) who had old grievances and territorial ambitions against Judah.

(2) 7 Steps to pray for a Miracle

#1 Worth Worrying about, Worth Praying about

Then Jehoshaphat was afraid and set his face to seek the LORD, and proclaimed a fast throughout all Judah.

2 Chronicles 20:3 (ESV)



#2 Enlist other people to pray and support you

And Judah assembled to seek help from the LORD; from all the cities of Judah they came to seek the LORD.

2 Chronicles 20:4 (ESV)



#3 Remember God has all the power you need

And Jehoshaphat stood in the assembly of Judah and Jerusalem, in the house of the LORD, before the new court, and said, "O LORD, God of our fathers, are you not God in heaven? You rule over all the kingdoms of the nations. In your hand are power and might, so that none is able to withstand you. Did you not, our God, drive out the inhabitants of this land before your people Israel, and give it forever to the descendants of Abraham your friend?

2 Chronicles 20:5-7 (ESV)



#3 Remember God has all the power you need

(a) Remember God is all you need.

(b) Remember God has helped you **many times** in the past. This is not the first time you have had a problem.

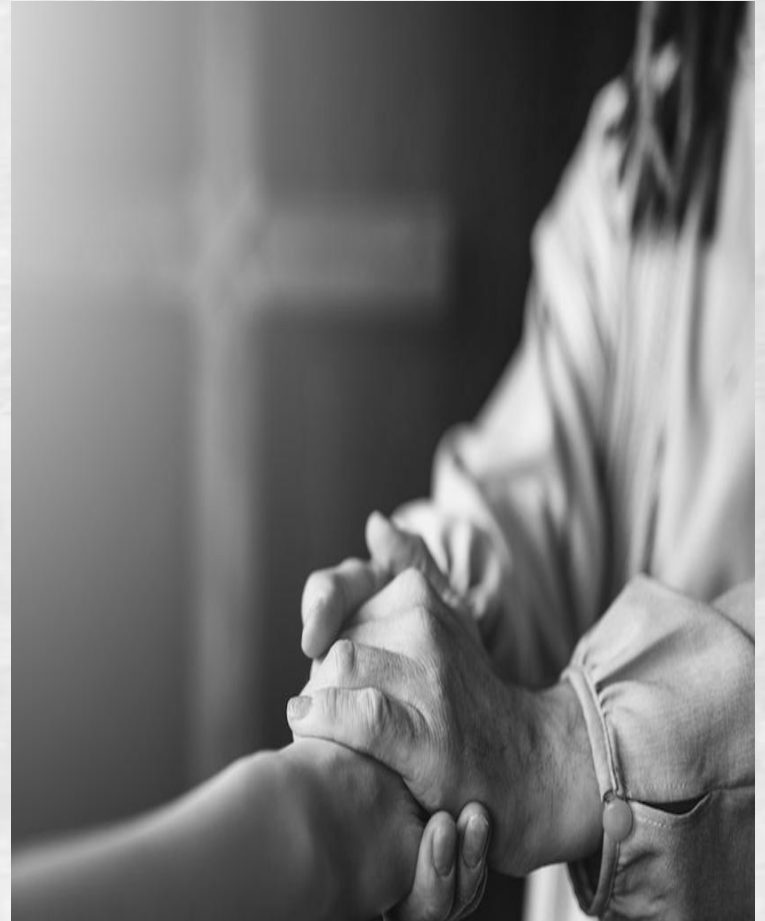
(c) Remember God always keeps His promises.



#4 Be specific

2 Chronicles 20:12 (ESV)

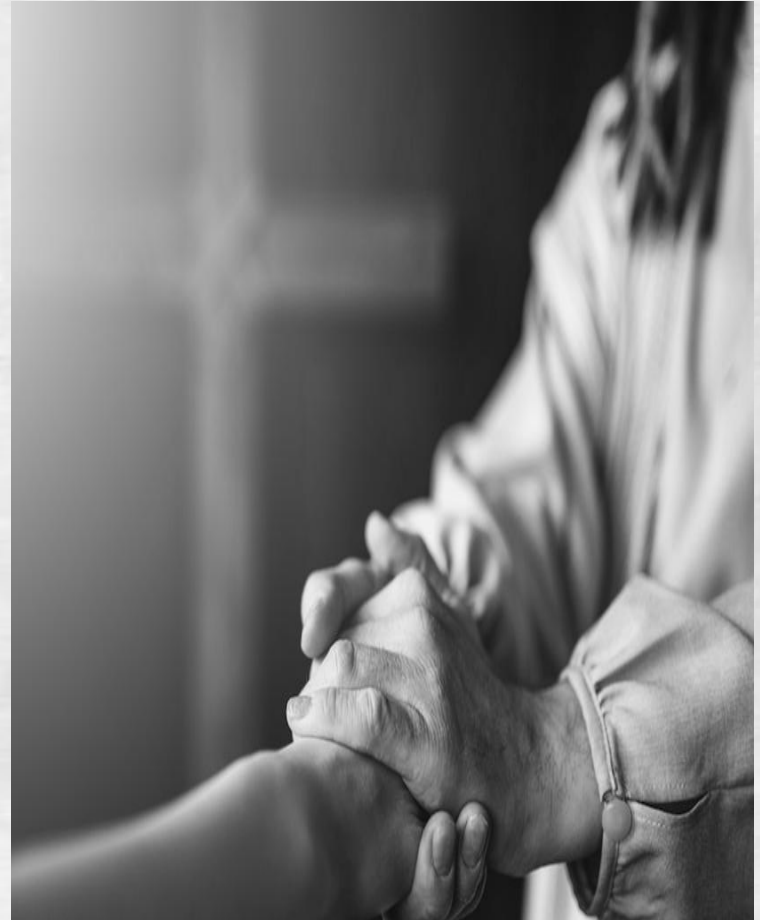


#4 Be specific

(a) Don't waste your breath on non-passionate prayers

(b) God listens to passionate and desperate prayers.

(c) Don't just say "God, bless me"

(2 Kings 20:1-6)

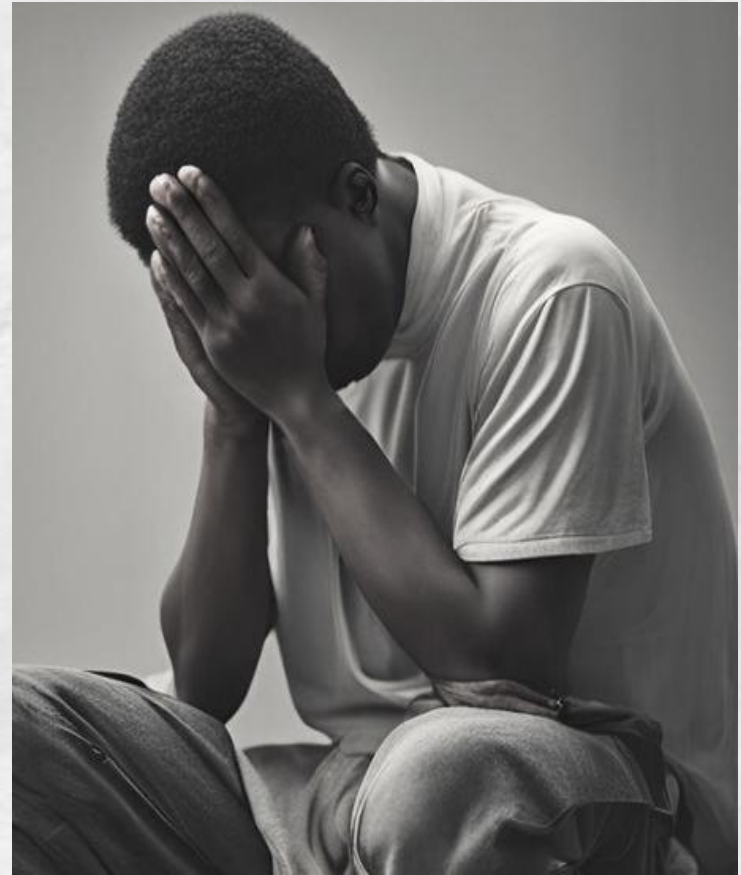
04 The Thief on the Cross – A Final Cry

#5 Admit you can't fix or solve the problem

(a) Salvation requires humility.
“My way is not working.”

(b) Lifeguard Analogy.



#6 Do whatever God tells you to

And he said, “Listen, all Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem and King Jehoshaphat: Thus says the LORD to you, ‘Do not be afraid and do not be dismayed at this great horde, for the battle is not yours but God's.

2 Chronicles 20:15 (ESV)



#7 Be grateful to God for His Blessings

Then Jehoshaphat bowed his head with his face to the ground, and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem fell down before the LORD, worshipping the LORD. And the Levites, of the Kohathites and the Korahites, stood up to praise the LORD, the God of Israel, with a very loud voice.

2 Chronicles 20:18 (ESV)



#7 Be grateful to God for His Blessings

On the fourth day they assembled in the Valley of Beracah, for there they blessed the LORD. Therefore the name of that place has been called the Valley of Beracah to this day.

2 Chronicles 20:26 (ESV)

- (a) The Battle is not yours but God's.
- (b) They named the battlefield as "blessings".
God will turn your battlefield into blessings.



What happens when Christians pray the breakthrough prayers?

(1) The World is witness to God.

(2) God's people enjoy peace.



²⁹ And the fear of God came on all the kingdoms of the countries when they heard that the LORD had fought against the enemies of Israel. ³⁰ So the realm of Jehoshaphat was quiet, for his God gave him rest all around.

7 Steps to pray for a Breakthrough



- (1) Worth worrying about, Worth praying about.
- (2) Enlist other people to pray and support you.
- (3) Remember God has all the power you need.
- (4) Be Specific.
- (5) Admit you can't fix or solve the problem.
- (6) Do whatever God tells you to do.
- (7) Be grateful to God for His Blessings.
