

If you are from the United States and are looking for a textbook format that follows the same pattern that all other language textbooks use for languages such as Spanish and French... The short answer is no. There are Irish language textbooks in the format you speak. You can find them online. However, they are made in Ireland for Irish language students who are usually outside the basics. These textbooks, used in Irish secondary and higher education, are only Irish. So if you don't have a mid-level Irish, they really aren't worth your time or money... So no, there is no Irish textbook for a beginner in this type of format. The only real Irish textbook that takes a person from non-Irish to a basic/medium level Of Irish is still learning Irish by Mechel and Siadhail. What you are experiencing is one of the great drawbacks of Irish training materials... There are many introductory materials that give a taste of the language, but don't leave you no place to go from there. I'm sure it's only a matter of time before someone creates one, but you have to remember the surge of Irish interest in higher education from Ireland is still quite recent. These materials will come from countries other than Ireland because Ireland still refuses to approach the issue as an English language foreign language. And I think that's the type of tutorial you're looking for. If you're familiar with McGraw Hill, they said they're now willing to publish a test run for language course on the lines of their French Vis-A-Vis, German Wie Geht's, Italian Prego... and all there are other languages. However, they are waiting for someone to propose. And because of the level of risk, they are looking for more reliable authors. In other words, if you're not a group of native speakers, or fancy a degree in Irish/Celtic studies... Don't waste your time with them. If something is wrong, those who have the opportunity to take action are responsible for the actions. In addition, the grammatical notes are quite short and not particularly detailed.
