Stepping into 2026...

The new year is unfolding in a splendid manner. As we take each step, we can do so intentionally, with purpose and grace, for the glory of God. Here are 3 baby steps to help you get started in the year of the horse.

1. A New Mindset

As I mentioned in my sermon last week, whatever we do, we need to pray, as the lyrics of the hymn *Dear Lord and Father of Mankind* plead, "re clothe us in our rightful minds."

There is no better way to do this than to wake up a few minutes earlier to do our daily devotion with *Power for Today*.

If you cannot do it at home, take it with you to your school or work and do it before lunch. I do not recommend doing it in the evening as you will miss the benefit of God's guiding word through the day.

2. Be Aware of People

Do not be glued to your phone when you are not by yourself. Look around you and sense the people that God has placed amongst you. Just as you can tell from the way others carry themselves, they can see your faith by your disposition.

Is there someone you can give up your seat to

the bus or mrt? Can you slow your pace and walk along with a person using a cane as you cross the road?

3. Do Something Positive

Last Sunday I quoted from Mark 9:41 *"For whoever will give you a cup of water to drink in my name, because you are Christ's, most assuredly I tell you, he will in no way lose his reward."*

God does not demand all of us to give up our lives for Him. He appreciates just as much when we are kind to another with a cup of water.

Sometimes a tissue seller will come to your table. At another time, you may pass a person on a wheelchair selling some snacks. It could very well be someone in your class or workplace who needs your encouragement.

Do not let a day go by without doing something positive. Let your family and friends know how much you love and care for them.

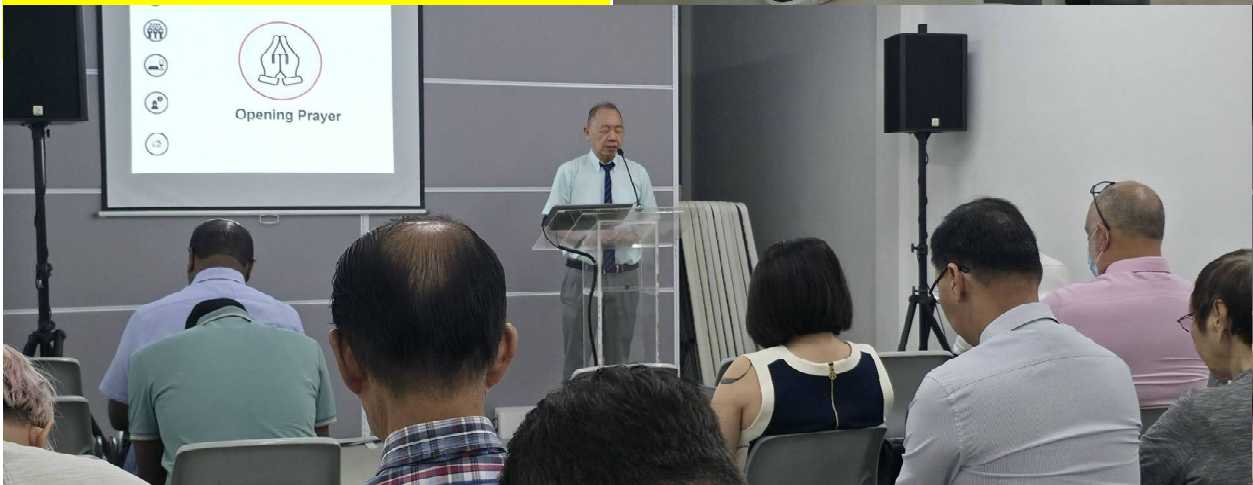
