

HOW ACCURATE OR COMPLETE THE AD COPY IS:

It's accurate enough as the 5-page Table of Contents would make the ad copy quite long. One helpful thing to do is that the first half of the book is presented as a fictional narrative involving a journalist named Denise who's assigned by her boss, Mr. Hernan to investigate the paranormal goings on in Copenhagen. Throughout, she has experiences which are mysteries. The second half of the book explains those mysteries as well as some essays on the subject.

****MY COMMENTS****

Dennis Hermanzo consistently delivers inspiring theatrical experiences, and this book doesn't break the streak, although it's quite different in structure than most you'll read. It's a huge 366 page, 9" x 12" (approx.) book, no dust jacket. The first half of the book comprises a fictional narrative that involves a journalist named Denise who's assigned by her boss, Mr. Hernan to investigate the paranormal goings on in Copenhagen. There are nearly three dozen chapters filled with routines and mysteries. In the second half of the book, Dennis provides the explanations for the mysteries described in the first half.

The routines themselves run the gamut of the classics and the expected mentalism plots. Running down each of them would make my comments extremely long and I don't think that's necessary. Dennis does not shy away from using plots that are well-established crowd pleasers and there's absolutely nothing wrong with that. If you're looking for new techniques or principles, though, this may be a disappointment. However, this is a fun, unique read and it certainly put some ideas in my head that I may use later to adapt to my work. I'm sure you'll get something out of this, too.
