- 1. Please enter all information in the booking form. To confirm your reservation, a deposit of 30% of the tour fee is required. If the departure date of the tour is within 15 days, the full amount of the tour fee should be paid.
- 2. Passport must be valid for a minimum of 6 months from the day of arrival at your destination. Please note: Participation in the Brown line and Orange Line(Summer:March September) requires holding a Schengen multiple-entry visa.
- 3. Agents are not authorized to sell tours for less or more than official price listed. goEUgo Does not accept liability for any complaints concerning price discrepancies.
- 4. Please read the terms & conditions to understand what is and is not included in the price.

#### 5. CANCELLATIONS, RESCHEDULE AND REFUNDS

Please read carefully the cancellation and refund policy.

If you cancel your tour for any reason including medical or personal reasons, the following cancellation/refund charges will apply:

- 16 days prior departure No extra cost for changes to prior or later departure. In case of cancellation - Full refund
- 15-08 days prior departure 50% of invoice will be deducted for cancellation and rescheduling
- Less than 7 days prior departure NO REFUND will be given for cancellation and rescheduling
- 6. For single traveller, you can choose to share a standard twin room with same gender which will be arranged by goEUgo. In case of not having another traveller to share with, no extra charge will be applied. For participants who prefer single occupancy (no sharing), this can be arranged by paying a single supplement fee of € 60 per person/night. This preference must indicated at time of booking. Once the booking is confirmed, it will not be possible to amend the room choice

while on tour. If you wish to change to single occupation during the tour, €120 per night will be charged.

- 7. For pre and post tour accommodation it is not possible to provide a shared twin room. Single participant has to pay € 60 extra per night per person for single room occupancy.
- 8. When a group consists of two adults and one child, if the child is between 2 and 11 years old, they will be charged at the children's rate. The child will not be provided with a separate bed and must share a room with the two adults. If the group consists of two adults and two children, the price will be calculated as if for four adults. The room arrangement will have one adult and one child per room, with the children occupying a bed and charged at the adult rate.
- 9. For minors under 18, pregnant women, or seniors (70+), they must be accompanied by at least one adult relative or friend (under 65) in order for their participation to be accepted. Note: Participants who are pregnant or seniors (70+) must sign a "Participant Commitment and Waiver of Liability" at the time of registration for mutual protection. We also recommend that pregnant women or seniors purchase appropriate insurance products before joining the tour.
- 10. Full payment must be received 16 days prior to the departure date, we reserve the right to annul bookings if full balance is not received by the final due date.
- 11. After confirmation, the agent issues a Tour Voucher to the tour participants via the system. Vouchers must be issued by goEUgo. If Agents use their own voucher, any additional, missing, or altered information or terms will not be recognized by goEUgo, and we reserve the right to pursue all related responsibilities.

- 1. Each participant is allowed to bring one luggage on board (weight below 30kg, the sum of length, width and depth must not exceed 158cm). If passenger brings more than one luggage (given that there is space available to store) each additional piece of luggage will be charged €5/ day (£5/ day for purple line). Availability to accommodate extra luggages cannot be guaranteed.
- 2. Most attractions points in Europe cannot be reached directly by coaches, and will require participants to travel on foot. If the participants are of limited mobility, this tour may not be suitable for you. We cannot offer compensation or refunds for missed attractions, so please think twice before joining the tour. Once the booking is completed, it also means accepting the terms and conditions set by the tour operator.
- 3. Tour managers and drivers are your hosts during the tour. They will help you explore and make the most of your time. Their passion for travel and local knowledge will enrich your holiday experience. Gratuity is paid directly to the tour manager and driverwhen the tour is over. We have set a obligatory tip of € 10 / £ 10 per passenger per day during your tour. Please prepare cash as a token of your appreciation.
- 4. Present your Booking Voucher to the tour manager when you board the coach. goEUgo cannot allow delays by a single passenger or group. A participant's negligence and late arrival can result in missed connections for other passengers. In case of emergencies, please call our emergency numbers as printed on your Booking Voucher.
- 5. Participants are responsible for carrying valid travel documents (passport) and visas, with a validity period of no less than six months from the departure date. In any situation or for any reason, if entry is refused by immigration (customs), our company will not be held responsible. All losses incurred will be the sole responsibility of the participant, and no refund of the tour fees will be provided.
- 6. Please avoid bringing valuables and precious jewellery. Keep all your valuable personal belongings with you, this includes passport and money. The tour company, driver and the tour manager will not be responsible for any losses incurred.
- 7. All tour participants must abide by the laws of the countries they visit. It is strictly prohibited to carry contraband or illegal goods for profit. Smoking is strictly forbidden in all public spaces and indoor areas across Europe, including hotel rooms, with fines reaching up to thousands of euros. We kindly remind participants to comply with these regulations. In recent years, some well-known European buildings (tourist sites) have prohibited visitors from sitting on the ground to rest or eat. Not only is this considered disrespectful, but it may also result in immediate fines.
- 8. Please ensure that you have sufficient cash to pay for meals and entrance tickets. Do refer to the Optional On-Tour Price List. Meals, tips and expenses are payable on top of the tour price and itinerary. Please remember to pack prescribed medication, motion sickness medication, and other essentials for personal use.
- 9. If a participant, under any circumstances or for personal reasons, wishes to depart on their own, return separately, or leave the group midway through the tour, our company will certainly assist with the arrangements. However, our company will not be responsible for any indirect or direct financial losses due to delays in transportation or any other issues that prevent the participant from meeting the pre-arranged itinerary or accommodation.
- 10. If any participant deliberately obstructs the tour leader's work, endangers the safety of others, or negatively impacts the group's activities and interests, the tour leader has the right, based on the specific situation or with the approval of the majority of participants, to revoke that individual's right to continue with the tour. The participant will be ordered to leave the group, and no refund will be provided for the unfinished portion of the trip. After leaving the group, all actions taken by the participant are entirely their own responsibility, and our company will bear no further responsibility.

In cases of lost luggage, accidents, injuries, or property damage, the rules established by these organizations will be followed to resolve the matter, and our company will not be held responsible.
- 15. Purchase of European travel insurance is strongly recommended. Please ensure that you are sufficiently covered for your entire trip. You may consult the tour agency and our company for relevant insurance applications.
- 16. Due to the fact that certain bus models may not be able to accommodate wheelchairs, we regret that we cannot accept registrations from participants who use wheelchairs. (Note: For "private tours," prior notification is required before quoting.)

#### PRECAUTIONS FOR TRANSFERS SERVICES

- 1. The airport transfer service is a group pick-up and drop-off service. The driver is only responsible for the transfer from the airport to the group hotel and does not have any information regarding the goEUgo tour and tour group.
- 2. Guests who have booked the airport transfer service should confirm that their name and telephone number are correct and up to date prior their departure. Please make sure guests' mobile phone and mobile phone subscription can receive calls in Europe by enabling mobile phone roaming!
- 3. After arrival at the destination airport, it will take guests at least 30 45 minutes to pick up their luggage and go through border control. The transfer driver will wait for the guests at the airport 30 minutes after the arrival time of the guests at the airport.
- 4. The waiting time at the airport of the driver for the client for the transfer service is maximum 90 minutes after the arrival time of the flight, in case the waiting time is exceeded the driver may leave and is not liable for doing so. In the occurrence the driver needs to return to the airport to pick up the guests after the 90 minutes waiting time, a new service charge is applicable. If the flight is delayed by the airline and the transfer driver is not notified in a timely matter the transfer fee is non-refundable. Guests can try to claim compensation of the transfer fee from the airline themselves.

- 5. Regardless whether guests need to pick up checked baggage or not, they should go to the correct flight baggage conveyor belt number in order use the correct exit of the arrival hall and not take a random exit. The driver shall be waiting at the arrival hall exit of the designated flight with a name board of the registered client. If the guests are unable to find the driver with the correct name board, there is no need to panic. Client should remain in the area and call the emergency number +31-643 448 738 for inquiries.
- 6. If the guests know their flight is delayed, changed, or cancelled, guests should send a SMS and/or call the emergency number +31-643 448 738 to amend the transfer arrangement. Our operations team will do its best effort to reschedule the transfer. However, there is no guarantee the transfer arrangement can be changed. The transfer fee is non-refundable whether the transfer arrangement can be amended or not. Client can try to claim compensation from the airline. If guests need assistance upon arrival, they can call our team on the emergency number.
- 7. The transfer service from group hotel to the airport is arranged four hours prior to the scheduled flight departure time. If the guests experience any delay to its departure airport such as traffic jams, accidents, and other unforeseen events, our team will do its best efforts to solve the situation. However, if guests are unable to board their flights due to a force majeure as mentioned above, goEUgo is not liable under any circumstances.
- 8. The allowed number of baggage pieces per client is two pieces (one cabin baggage piece and one check-in baggage piece). Any other baggage pieces exceeding this number is subject to a surcharge fee of 20 euro per extra piece of baggage.

#### PRECAUTIONS FOR PRE- AND POST- TOUR ACCOMMODATION

- 1. Guests who have booked a pre-tour accommodation they can check in at the hotel's reception using the booking under the name of 【goEUgo Limited】, please provide the hotel reception the issued hotel voucher. A passport is required for hotel check-in. If guests have ordered a transfer from goEUgo the driver will transfer guests to group hotel.
- 2. Please note that international and European hotels usually have a check-in time at 3:00 pm. If guests arrive prior to the check-in time of the hotel and the room is not yet available. They can rest in the hotel lobby or guests can leave their luggage at the reception (if possible) and spend some time outside and return to check-in at 3:00 pm. Thank you for your understanding!
- 3. The temperature difference between day and night in Europe can be big and the annual average temperature exceeding 30 degrees Celsius is at most two months. Please note, European countries have a strong awareness of environmental protection, therefore some hotels in Europe are not equipped with air-conditioning. This lack of air-conditioning does not mean the hotel facilities are not up to standard. Thank you for your understanding.
- 4. Our tour guide will arrive with the group at the hotel usually between 8:00 9:00 pm on the day guests check-in for their pre-tour accommodation. The tour guide will contact guests at the hotel to inform them about next day departure time of the tour group. In case the tour guide is not able to contact the self-checked-in guests, the guide will leave a note for the guests at their hotel room door. Usually breakfast next day is at 7:00 am, if guests go to attend breakfast, they will be able to meet the tour guide and the other group members.
- 5. Guests who have booked a post-tour accommodation will not need to worry. The tour guide will send the guests directly to the hotel where they will stay after ending their tour. If guests also booked a transfer from the hotel to the airport the tour guide will provide the time and details of the transfer service.
- 6. The pre-tour and post-tour accommodation is only an additional support service so our team is not able to help guests to arrange shared twin room option. Please understand.

The morning begins with a leisurely drive north-west from Frankfurt to Bonn, the capital of the former West Germany until reunification. The national government is now in Berlin, but Bonn retains a rich history that is well worth exploring. Discover the city's secrets on an orientation stroll through its streets, walking past highlights such as the Rococo-fronted town hall and Ludwig Van Beethoven Haus, a museum celebrating the life of the much-loved composer. Then heading to Cologne, where you'll go inside the city's glorious Gothic Cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The rest of the afternoon is yours to explore Cologne further, to do local shopping or to simply relax with a suitably refreshing German brew. After lunch the day is rounded off with a drive in the Netherlands.

A day of delights begins with a leisurely trip through the Dutch countryside, where you'll get to sample at close quarters some of the things that the Netherlands is traditionally famous for: clogs, cheese and windmills. Call in at the hugely popular model town of *Zaanse Schans*. Next, you'll head from the quiet countryside to the cosmopolitan city as the journey takes you back to Amsterdam. After lunch, you'll walk to one of the city's grandest areas, *Dam Square*, where the Royal Palace is located and the King's birthday celebration takes place. Then head to a well-known *diamond factory*, where you'll see the unique cutting techniques that have been practised here since the 16th century, you can take an optional hour-long pre-dinner canal cruise, which is a great way to discover more about this unique European city. After dinner, you will check in the hotel and enjoy your free time for shopping or further sightseeing. *Overnight stay in Amsterdam or city nearby*

After leaving Amsterdam in the morning you'll head south across the border into Brussels, the Belgian capital and political centre of the European Union. On the way, the tour stops to see the distinctive *Atomium monument*, a cell-shaped structure of stainless-steel spheres and tubes built for the 1958 World's Fair. #### [Tuesday] Bratislava (330 km)

After having breakfast at the hotel, you'll leave Barcelona for Spain's third largest city, Valencia. In Valencia's history, the city was celebrated as the gateway to the Mediterranean. It's commercially and culturally rich, with Moorish and Arab culture and food. Although today's Valencia is less prominent, it's still an important city for large commerce exhibitions and trade fairs to be held in throughout the year. #### [Wednesday] Granada → Ronda → Seville (312km)

In the morning, Embark on a self-paid group activity in the morning and head to Ronda, the birthplace of Spanish bullfighters. Ronda proudly holds the distinction of being home to Spain's oldest bullring, where the love, hatred, and passion of the fighters of that era were witnessed. Despite its seemingly serene facade, Ronda emanates a vibrant Spanish charm that is unmatched. The town's romantic and peaceful white houses perched on the dramatic cliffs serve as a testament to its allure. Then tour will go northbound to the largest city of the autonomous region of Andalusia, Seville. This city was the capital of the Muslim dynasty, considered to be the guardian angel of culture in Andalusia and the birthplace of the flamenco dance. Seville is the primary setting of many operas, of which the best known is Bizet's Carmen. As the fourth largest city in Spain, it has hosted the Universal Exposition of Seville in 1992. Upon arrival, you will visit the Seville Cathedral, the largest Gothic cathedral and the third-largest church in the world. Its completion dates back to the early 16th century and now the cathedral halls serve as the Royal Chapel, the burial place of the kings for over a century. The tomb of Christopher Columbus, who discovered the New World, is also in the church as a credit to the great navigator. From there onwards you will see the Alcázar of Seville, which used to be a Muslim palace and a Spanish Royal Palace. The upper levels of the Alcázar are still used by the royal family as the official Seville residence today, which makes it the oldest royal palace still in use in Europe. It was registered in 1987 by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site, along with the Seville Cathedral. We will walk to Santa Cruz. Torre del Oro (the Tower of Gold) and *Maria Luisa Park*, where the 1992 World Expo was located. In *Plaza de España* (Spain Square), you can admire crafted porcelain paintings, detailing the history and elegance of historical Spain.

Today the tour departs for the capital and the largest city of Portugal, Lisbon. You are expected to arrive in *Cabo da Roca* (Cape Roca) in the afternoon. This is the most western extent of mainland Portugal and continental Europe. At the cape, you can see the enormous Atlantic Ocean surrounded by endless scenery. Today we will drive back to Madrid via *Toledo*, a World Heritage Site declared by UNESCO in 1986 for its extensive cultural and monumental heritage. This old city is located on a mountaintop, surrounded on three sides by a bend in the Tagus River, and contains many historical buildings. By strolling across the city, overlooking the *Alcázar of Toledo* and visiting the grand structure of the *Toledo Cathedral*, you will feel the bustling of Spain in the old time. ### **[Thursday] ¬ ■ + Paris** → Avignon (690 km)

In the morning we will depart from Paris to arrive at the heart of the Provence, "Avignon," in the evening. This region of France is very diverse with lively cities, winding mountains that will change its distinct views depending on the season of the year. Let's take a break from the fashion and luxury of the big metropoles and head to the south of France. Enjoy the sceneries of picturesque small towns, wind down and appreciate nature and the rural culture. You will experience the romantic ambience of South France, visit Gordes, the most beautiful village of the Provence. Follow in Vincent van Gogh's footsteps in the small town of Arles and taste the world-renowned mellow flavor of Bordeaux wine, and visit the shopping paradise that is Andorra.

Overnight stay in Avignon or city nearby

### [Friday] Avignon→ Gordes→ Abbaye de Sénanque→ Avignon (200 km)

We will start the day in Avignon visiting the two must see landmarks. The Palais des Papes (Palace of the Popes) and the Pont Saint-Bénézet, the broken bridge which is also know as Pont d'Avignon. The palace dates to the 14<sup>th</sup> century, with the support from the King of France the Roman church moved its capital thus making Avignon the second religious capital of the Roman-Catholic church.

In the afternoon we will depart to visit Gordes, famous from A Year in Provence, the book, written by Peter Mayle. The village of Gordes is made of limestone dating back to 1525 with its buildings rooting themselves into the steep cliff giving the village town its other names; the Stone City and the City in the Sky. The village is considered by the Association des plus villages de France one of France's most beautiful villages.

Afterwards we will have a short stay at the Musee de la Lavande, the lavender museum, and the Abbaye de Sénanque which Catholic Cistercian originate from and the story background of the book A Year in Provence.

Overnight stay in Avignon or city nearby

#### **Saturday** Avignon→ Arles→ Barcelona + B = (500 km)

In the morning we will drive to Arles. The small town is famous because the well-known Dutch master of Impressionism, Vincent van Gogh, whom lived in the sanatorium of Arles from 1888 – 1889. Although Van Gogh stayed for only one year, that single year is considered the most productive period of his life. He painted more than two hundred oil paintings during his stay in Arles. Creating his world-renowned art pieces; The Langlois Bridge at Arles and The Café Terrace on the Place du Forum. It is a true unique experience to visit town and see what the Dutch master saw himself over a century ago. Other than enjoying the village's connection with Van Gogh there are many ancient Roman ruins to behold. Arles has been listed as a key city since ancient Roman times.

In the afternoon we will leave Arles for the charming coastal city of Barcelona. If time permits, upon arrival, everyone can participate in an optional program to visit the Olympic Beach.

In the morning we will travel to the Principality of Andorra. This microstate is located between France and Spain in the eastern Pyrenees. The state is surrounded by mountains and rough terrain. Its capital, Andorra la Vella, is Europe's highest capital with an elevation of 1,023 meters. Andorra is a popular destination for alpine skiing in Europe. Although most Asian travelers do not give Andorra much attention, it is certainly worth a visit with its beautiful sceneries. Also known for duty-free shopping it is a shopping paradise.

After lunch we will drive through the Pyrenees entering France arriving at the town of Lourdes. After our stop at the winery, we will head to city Bordeaux, visiting famous landmarks such as the opera house Gran Teatro de Burdeos, the world's largest water mirror called Miroir d'Eau and the famous Place des Quinconces and so on. The castle was originally built to serve as a hunting lodge for King Francois I of France in 1519 to make a statement of his imperial power. The King hired Italian artists and architects such as Leonardo da Vinci and Domenico da Cortona to attribute the brilliant art and architectural style of the Italian Renaissance. By doing this he laid the foundation of the French Renaissance. Afterwards will be heading to Paris and will arrive around 7 pm.

After breakfast, you continue your way to the capital of Sweden, Stockholm. Built on 14 islands in the Baltic Sea, this city is crowned the most beautiful of all Nordic cities. After lunch, we embark on a city tour that includes the *City Hall of Stockholm (Stadshuset)*, one of the most beautiful and well-known buildings in the world with inside the most exclusive ballroom in Stockholm, the venue of the yearly *Nobel Banquet*. The Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina is the focus of today's itinerary and was originally one of the six socialist republics of the former Yugoslavia. First stop today is **Počitelj**, the stepped medieval fortress village, which has now been included in the World Cultural Heritage List.
