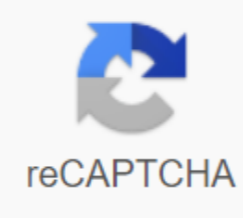

Now, following the release of Earthdawn's 4th edition of Player Guide PDF, FASA provides the official 4th edition of the characters record sheet on their download page. The ED4 Symbol Sheet Writing sheet uses a D12 bone table, and it provides a two-page space for basic character statistics. I'd say it's not helpful for high-circle characters, but to start with it should be good enough. It just provides basic stats of your character in a good review, no more. It is a common cause of prenatal hemorrhage. Placenta previa is a potentially life-threatening condition for both mother and baby. Thus, antenatal diagnosis is essential for adequate preparation for childbirth. Placenta previa has a incidence of 1/200 pregnancies. Placenta previa is associated with a number of risk factors, including: abnormal placental cjudicial adherence (5%); for example, Placenta accretane previa usually presents with painless vaginal bleeding in the second half of pregnancy (20 weeks of pregnancy), most often between 34-38 weeks of pregnancy. Other related clinical features include: high fetal representation of the part of the maternal/fetal compromise secondary in relation to the exsanguination term placenta previa covers the spectrum of abnormalities and the results of partial or complete insertion of the placenta in the uterine segment. Previa is divided into four varieties depending on the ratio and distance to the inner cervix OS: Class I: low-lying placenta: the placenta lies in the lower segment of the uterus, but its lower edge is not adjacent to the inner cervix OS (i.e. the lower edge of 0.5-2.0 cm from the internal OS). Grade II: Marginal previa: placental tissue reaches the edge of the inner cervix OS, but does not cover its Grade III: partial previa: the placenta partially covers the inner cervix OS Class IV: full previa: the placenta fully covers the inner cervieus OS Sometimes grades I and II are called minor or partial placenta previa. And classes III and IV are called the main placenta previa 5.Because of placenta trophotropism, the diagnosis During the routine 18-21-week scan of morphology should measure the distance between the lower edge of the placenta and the internal OS. If it is a few centimetres from the cervix OS, then a re-ultrasound at 32 weeks should be performed to ensure that the edge migrates further. MRI is the gold standard of imaging for the placenta and its relationship to the cervix, although in most cases it is not required. Sagittarius best demonstrates the connection of the placenta with the inner cervical wasp. Low-lying placenta is relatively common in morphological scanning of the second trimester. As the fetus grows and the uterus expands, the lower the uterus thins and grows growing thus that in most cases the placenta is no longer low-lying through follow-up study (usually performed at 32-34 weeks). In the case of a full prevation of the placenta, a caesarean section is required for delivery to avoid the risk of hemorrhage of the fetus and the mother. Post-thought images should always be obtained if previa is suspected. Sometimes, a subchoric hematoma that extends over the cervix can mimic the placenta previa, especially if the hemorrhage is still echogenic. Subsequent images would be useful for distinguishing between the two entities. Transvaginal ultrasound scan is more accurate for assessing placenta previa, transabdomine scan can overdiagnose it up to one quarter of cases when spotted in the second trimester, third trimester ultrasound scans (32-34 weeks) must be performed to re-evaluate the position of the placenta position
