Your Mine Attractive Adjectives and Pronouns are used to show that something or someone belongs to a person. The possessive adjective is used with a noun, the own proun is used without a noun. The own proun replaces the possessive adjective and the noun: Examples: This laptop is his laptop, not my laptop. This laptop is his, not mine. Those keys are her keys, not her keys. Those keys are hers, not yours. Are those your motorcycles? Yes, they're ours. Is this your grandparents' house? Yes, it's them. It's not my sister's cat. Its much larger and has darker fur.
