Next, verify that push messages aren't being filtered out by your notification settings. If not, try signing back into your account or reinstalling the latest app version. Make sure your doorbell and chime are properly paired via RF 433MHz radio frequency. If they're already paired, move the chime closer to the doorbell and retry. Network issues can cause photo upload failures, so check your network connection and try again if necessary. For optimal performance, use AAA alkaline dry batteries (AA LR6 1.5V) in your X Smart Home doorbell. Other types of batteries might shorten the device's battery life or cause other problems. Configure your "Infrared fill light" status and "LED light" to suit your environment. Always keeping the infrared supplement light on can reduce the doorbell's lifespan, so consider setting it to automatic or always off instead. If you have a device with human body detection functionality, enable motion detection for enhanced security features. However, be aware that frequent motion detection can shorten battery life, so adjust settings according to your needs and corridor environment.
