Sept. 17 Home Cities to Montréal (2 nights)

Fly to Montréal where you will be **transferred to your downtown hotel** for a **two-night stay**.

Sept. 18 Montréal

This morning, an in depth **tour of Montréal** features **Notre Dame Cathedral** and **Mont Royal**. This afternoon you will want to explore this cosmopolitan city with its world-class shopping, quaint historic neighborhoods and spectacular eateries.

Sept. 19 Boston (2 nights)

Leaving La Belle Province - Quebec, we travel south through the rolling hills of **Vermont** on our way to Boston. A stop in **Burlington** at **Church Street Marketplace** is planned to explore the more than 100 shops and eateries surrounded by historic buildings. Founded in 1630, **Boston** is steeped in American Revolutionary War history. Our hotel is perfectly situated near many notable sites.

Sept. 20 Boston

Explore Boston at your own pace on board the **Hop-On Hop-Off Trolley**. With a stop near our hotel, this **fully narrated sightseeing tour** covers more than **100 points of interest** with **18 stops** including Boston's Historic Freedom Trail, Faneuil Hall, the "Cheers" bar, Beacon Hill, Old North Church, The Public Garden, the North End (an exclusive stop) and much more.

Featured Stops:

Bar Harbor

Located on Mount Desert Island in Maine, Bar Harbor is the quintessential New England coastal town. Picturesque and charming, it is a scenic and walkable town with streets lined with restaurants

and boutiques. Dining on lobster is a must, as is a scoop or two at one of the town's homemade ice cream shops.

Halifax

Located on a rocky inlet on the Atlantic, Halifax—Nova Scotia's provincial capital—is defined by its maritime geography. The sinking of the Titanic, The Citadel and Pier 21 are but a few highlights to explore.

Sydney

Sydney is the largest city on Cape Breton Island, which is linked by causeway to the rest of Nova Scotia. Sydney's attractions start at the harbour, where visitors can shop for locally made crafts and see the world's largest fiddle, which towers beside the port's cruise pavilion.

Charlottetown

Abegweit – "the land cradled on the waves"... and The Land of Anne of Green Gables, Prince Edward Island is arguably Canada's most picturesque province. Charlottetown is the capital as well as its largest city, though it has fewer than 35,000 residents. Despite its modest size, the city has an impressive number of Victorian houses and great parks waiting to be explored. Here, Province House, is where the Fathers of Confederation met in 1864 to discuss the beginnings of Canada as a nation.

Quebec City

Few places in North America are as steeped in history as Québec City. The walled historic district, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is home to religious orders that date back to the 17th century while the oldest commercial street in North America is alive with shops, sidewalk cafés and street entertainers.

Montréal

Montréal is a city of contrasts. Situated on the St. Lawrence River with towering glass high-rises, it also possesses an undeniable Old-World French flair.
