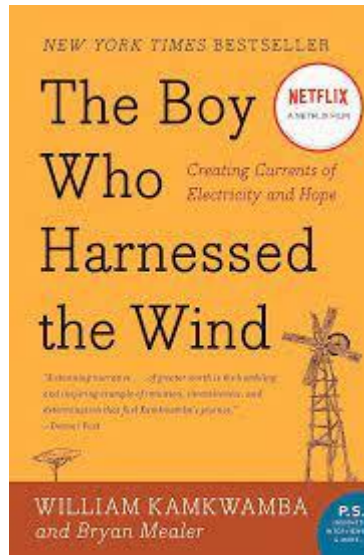




Directions:
