Fast Facts

- In 2017, the Asia-Pacific Nutritional Supplement market had a value of USD 44.02 billion, and it is projected to experience the most rapid expansion with a CAGR of 14.63% between 2018 and 2023¹.
- Between 2019 and 2027, the Asia Pacific region is anticipated to increase its current value in the global food cans market by 1.4 times². This region currently holds 18% of the market and is projected to experience a Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) of 5%, resulting in an incremental opportunity of US\$2.4 billion.
- During the period of 2020-2025, a market intelligence firm, Mordor Intelligence predicts that the Asia-Pacific market for ready meals is expected to experience a Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) of 8.79%³.
- According to Euromonitor, the dairy market in the Asia-Pacific region offers promising prospects, mainly due to China and India, which account for 52% and 19% of drinking milk sales respectively. Additionally, flavoured milks are gaining popularity in the region, with an anticipated compound annual growth rate of 4.6% from 2021 to 2028, according to a report by Report Linker⁴.
