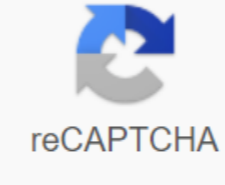

Choose Special Characters. 3. Change the Symbol into Latin. 4. Find an email with the accent you need, click on it, then OK. 5. Now it should be in your paper!B. Google Input Tools There is a Chrome extension called Google Input Tools you can use to quickly help with input. It's a bit glitchy and you can turn it off when you don't need it. When it's on, make sure you set it into French. While you enter, it gives you a pop-up box (as autocorrect does) with options. Be sure to choose the right option.C. Click here for a text box where you can type text and then copy-paste it anywhere you need it! D. Windows alt codes (only work on non-Chrome OS) E. Keyboard shortcuts for international characters: For keyboard shortcuts in which you press two or more keys at a time, press keys are separated by a plus sign (!) in the Microsoft Word help. For shortcuts in which you press one key immediately followed by another key, the press keys are separated by a comma (,). To enter the lower register symbol using a combination of keys that includes a SHIFT key, hold the CTRL-SHIFT-symbol keys at the same time and then release them before entering the letter.
