If you've spent the entire year taking an advanced placement course, the AP exam will be the highlight of the course – testing everything you've learned throughout the semester or year. It's important to perform well in exams as colleges will want to see your scores and that you understand the material – especially if they're on a course related to your areas of interest. In some cases, high AP scores can be used to course credit, allowing you to gain college credit before you even graduate from high school. This can go a long way toward reducing costs and allowing you to skip your freshman year entry level courses that may not be engaging or challenging, since you already know the material. AP is a program from the College Board that offers advanced courses to high school students to earn college credit, impact GPA, and enhance an academic transcription. The AP exam schedules for 2017 take place every May. More specifically, the Advanced Placement examinations take place in the weeks from 1 May to 5 May and from 8 May to 12 May. During these two weeks in the spring, each of the 33 people will be tested. Fortunately, students can take their AP on makeup dates if necessary, with or without an additional cost of \$45 depending on the occasion. 2017 Late-testing AP Exam Dates When Should Your Child Take AP Lessons? During the first two years of high school, freshmen and sophomores can develop academic interests that inspire them to take an advanced placement course in the subject. This is the best time to think about AP issues that your child may be about to take to a more rigorous level. When your child takes an AP course - whether as a freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior - it depends on his or her ability to excel in class, as students are allowed to take AP classes each year of high school. Most students who take AP courses do so during the junior year because they are ready to handle advanced material and can still use AP classes to enhance their their college. Keep in mind - if your child gets AP during the second half of the senior year, their performance in these categories probably won't affect admissions. Older people must apply a regular decision often by 1 January, submitting academic copies for examination before the start of the second semester courses. Older people who apply timely decision or early action often do so by 1 November, submitting copies even before the first first The lessons are over. AP Exams taken during the senior year can, however, count toward obtaining college credit and advanced placement. How Advanced Placement Classes can help you earn College Credit and Advanced Placement Students can earn both college credit and advanced placement by taking AP exams. What's the difference

between college credit and advanced placement, you might ask? Colleges that offer advanced placement for AP exam scores allow students to skip entry classes, enter higher-level classes and/or meet general education requirements. The ability to earn college credit and advanced placement depends on each college and your child's exam scores. You can find the AP credit policy for each college on the College Board's website. There are three benefits of obtaining college credit and/or advanced placement before stepping foot on campus: 1. Your child may more quickly dive into the academic area of their focus during the freshman year if the college offers advanced placement-based AP exam scores. 2. If the college offers credit based on AP Exam results, knocking out credits before entering college reduces the number of credits your child should graduate. This can save your family money on college tuition, especially for students who use AP credits to graduate early. 3. Your child can earn scholarship money with an AP Scholars Award, which is awarded based on AP exam scores. How to submit AP Exam Results to earn course credit and/or Advanced Placement Families must submit AP Exam Results to Colleges through the College Board in order to earn course credit and/or advanced placement. While colleges will see AP classes in your child's academic transcription, they will only see the official exam scores needed to earn credits through the college board portal. You can ask the College Board to send AP exam scores to colleges either on the test date, or after the test date, through a score report request. Colleges typically inform students of course credit and/or advanced placement earned during the summer. How Advanced Placement Courses Affect GPA The AP IS Not an exam? It's a challenging high school class. (1/3 of students who take an AP class choose not to take the exam in May.) Your child's performance in an AP class contributes to the college admissions profile, regardless of the AP Exam score. The most specific way an AP class in high school affects your child's chances of getting into college is the effect on GPA. Similarly to those in a price category, grades earned in an AP class count for more points if your child's school uses a weighted GPA, which is a GPA scale that represents class difficulty. For example, a student who receives an A in AP US History has a weighted GPA of 5.0. A student who an A in the I U.S. History curriculum has a weighted GPA of 4.0. On an unweighted GPA scale, both students have GPA 4.0. You can learn more about the difference between weighted and unweighted GPA here. How Advanced Placement Classes can enhance an academic transcription A good grade in an AP class increases your child's weighted GPA, which very directly improves his or her chances of getting to a particular college. However, in addition to the effect on GPA, do AP classes improve your child's copy? Here's the simple answer: Yes. Jeff Rickey, Dean of Admissions at The University of St. Lawrence, says this in an interview with The New York Times: Selective institutions that perform a holistic review will first compare the lessons the student has taken with the courses offered at the school. If A.P. courses are offered, we would expect to see a.p. courses in the copy. If the price courses are the highest level, then we would expect to see them. Then we will look at the grades in academic courses during the arc of years, but also each year individually. This allows us to see performance over time and determine any trends. A downward trend is worrying when the assessment is carried out. An upward trend tells another story. Finally, we will look for selection courses, which give us other hints about the student's interests and may validate other parts of the student's application. Here's the most complicated answer: Yes, but not always. Like Mr. Rickey touches, course rigour is just one component of a diversified admission profile. If adding that an extra AP class stretches your child so thin that his or her overall GPA suffers, he or she should skip varsity lacrosse try-outs, or he or she doesn't have time to prepare for the SAT or ACT, then he or she could do more harm than good.
