





The Trouble with Memory

Professor Maryanne Garry of the NZ Institute of Security & Crime Science, Uni of Waikato will present a lecture on Memory.

Most people think memory is a faithful recorder & archiver of experience. But memory is a liar, a con artist, & a self-serving autobiographer. Memory causes trouble for us, & for others.

Yet without memory, we couldn't function, & our institutions would collapse. In this lecture, Professor Garry will present some of the science of memory, & talk about when & how memory causes trouble.

Maryanne Garry received her PhD in 1993 from the Uni of Connecticut, & did postdoctoral work at the Uni of Washington. In 1996 she moved to Victoria Uni of Wellington, where she worked for 20yrs before taking up a joint appointment in 2016 at the Uni of Waikato, as a Professor of Psychology & a Professor in the NZ Institute for Security & Crime Science (one of only two in the world) at The Uni of Waikato.

She studies a puzzle of memory: how is that otherwise intelligent, rational people can remember things they never really saw, or experiences they never really had? Over the years, she has amassed a solid body of theoretically-grounded applied research that helps us shed light on the causes & consequences of these false memories. Her work has been funded by granting agencies in the US, Japan, & in NZ, where she has been awarded four Marsden grants from the Royal Society. 




Satellite (until 7 Oct)

Tēnei Tonu Exhibition (until 21 Dec)

This stunning exhibition features a broad range of historic & contemporary taonga from the collection of the Hawke's Bay Museums Trust, Ruawharo Ta-u-rangi. Translated as 'always here', Tēnei Tonu shares diverse stories of local Iwi Ngati Kahungunu & their enduring connection to the land.

Ten taonga riri (weapons) have recently come out of storage & are on now on display - some have not been exhibited for over 100yrs'. They are representative of the nearly 200 taiaha & tewhatewha held in the collection, ranging from pre-contact through to the 1940s they show a variety of styles & materials.

One of the items on display is a beautiful whale-bone taiaha, & if you look closely you will see one eye has been rimmed with red wax & the other with paua - making for an unusual finished look.
