


Avent express microwave steam steriliser instructions

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Athena Hessong Updated July 21, 2017 Things You'll Need Measuring Cup included with Avent Children's Tongs Sterilizer included with Avent Express sterilizer sterilizing baby bottles in the microwave. It will pair six 4-ounce Avent brand baby water bottles. The portability of this sterilizer makes it easy tote while traveling. Once the Avent Express sterilizer is heated in the microwave, if left closed, the bottles inside will remain sterile for up to 24 hours. Remove the lid from the sterilizer and place the children's bottles upside down over the holders. Place the nipples with the open side down into the bottle lid holders. Fill a measuring cup, turned on with a sterilizer, to the water line. Pour water into the steamer. Attach the lid to the steamer and clamp down the side handles to block it in place. Heat the Avent Express at high power for two minutes for a 1100-watt or higher power oven; four minutes for an oven with a capacity of 850 to 1000 watts; or six minutes for microwave ovens with less power. Remove the Avent Express from the microwave and wait two minutes until it cools slightly before removing the lid. Keep your face and hands away from the couple's escape. Lift the bottles and nipples with tongs included with the sterilizer.
