IV Depravity - Starving the Spirit, Feeding the Flesh.

These are people in an oblivious spiritual funk. They are lost in the sense that their quest for looking out for themselves seems to be working out for them. There is no yearning for a devotion to God, in fact they are quick to run to evil. The devil has them disqualified for now in a demonic strategy for them to unknowingly miss out.






III Depletion - Famishing the Spirit, Starving the Flesh.


The bible warns of such condition when the apostle Paul references the story of creation in <u>2 Corinthians 11:2-4</u>, "But I am afraid that just as Eve was deceived by the serpent's cunning, your minds may somehow be led astray from your sincere and pure devotion to Christ."

Paul later recognized that God could use these trials as a wake up call. "Now I rejoice in what was suffered for you, and I fill up in my flesh what is still lacking in regard to Christ's afflictions, for the sake of his body, which is the church. (Colossians 1:23-25) Here is a great prayer for such a condition. "Teach me to do your will, for you are my God; may your good Spirit lead me on level ground." (Psalm 143:9-11). There is always hope with life in the Spirit even in "depletion".

Il Destruction - Sustaining the Spirit, Feeding the Flesh.

This is where the battle zone is especially for the Christian who has both devotion with God, yet also gives way to temptations and is not regularly experiencing victory in their lives. Many people unwillingly stay in this area of the grid.

It is like an owner of two hungry dogs with enough food for only one. The owner divvies up the food to each of the hungry dogs here and there. This indecision and lack of a clear stand allows both dogs to remain hungry and never fully satisfied. Frustration from the foothold of the "evil" dog and conviction from the "holy" dog makes for a lack of fulfillment and failure overall spiritually.

For when we were controlled by the sinful nature, the sinful passions aroused by the law were at work in our bodies, so that we bore fruit for death. (Romans 7:4-6)

I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature. For I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out. (Romans 7:17-19)

Colossians 1:10-12 And we pray this in order that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and may please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God ¹¹being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience, and joyfully ¹²giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in the kingdom of light.

Galatians 5:13-26 13 You, my brothers, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the sinful nature; rather, serve one another in love. ¹⁴The entire law is summed up in a single command: "Love your neighbor as yourself." ¹⁵If you keep on biting and devouring each other, watch out or you will be destroyed by

each other.

¹⁶So I say, live by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature. ¹⁷For the sinful nature desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the sinful nature. They are in conflict with each other, so that you do not do what you want. ¹⁸But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under law. ¹⁹The acts of the sinful nature are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; ²⁰idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions ²¹and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God.

²²But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. ²⁴Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the sinful nature with its passions and desires. ²⁵Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit. ²⁶Let us not become conceited, provoking and envying each other.

1 Devotion - Sustaining The Spirit and Famishing The Flesh

Here is where the fruits of the spirit are reflected in your life. The joy of the Lord becomes your strength. It is what Christ had in mind when He said He came to give us abundant life. This is the safe dwelling place of the Lord.

Il Destruction – Sustaining The Spirit and Feeding The Flesh

This is a battle zone that fans the flames of temptation and spiritual warfare. As long as you try to serve both God and the world there will be internal conflict. Believers often backslide as they continue to they feed their flesh.

III Depletion - Starving The Spirit and Famishing The Flesh

Many in this zone try to empty their heart and soul in an attempt to find harmony and inner peace. The result is often a meaningless spiritual void. New age philosophies and eastern religions have their roots here.

III Depravity – Starving The Spirit and Feeding The Flesh

This zone is the home of evil, wickedness and immorality. Without a godly foundation many give in to the cravings of the sinful nature following its desires. This condition was reflected in Sodom and Gomorrah.

Bad Fruit – Acts of the Sinful Nature



Immorality – not moral - conflicting with generally or traditionally held moral principles.

Impurity – not pure - containing something unclean - lacking legal or moral restraints - disregarding sexual restraints.

Debauchery – extreme indulgence in sensuality.

Drunkenness – to excite or stupefy by alcohol or a drug especially to the point where physical and mental control is markedly diminished.

Orgies - drunken revelry - a sexual encounter involving many people - an excessive sexual indulgence - something that resembles an orgy in lack of control or moderation.

Idolatry - the worship of a physical object as a god - immoderate attachment or devotion to something.

Witchcraft - the use of sorcery or magic - communication with the devil or with a familiar - an irresistible influence or fascination.

Discord - lack of agreement or harmony (as between persons, things, or ideas) - active quarreling or conflict resulting from discord among persons or factions.

Dissensions – disagreement - partisan and contentious quarreling.

Factions - a party or group that is often contentious or self-seeking - party spirit especially when marked by dissension.

Selfish - concerned excessively or exclusively with oneself - seeking or concentrating on one's own advantage, pleasure, or well-being without regard for others.

Hatred - prejudiced hostility or animosity.

Jealousy - intolerant of rivalry or unfaithfulness -disposed to suspect rivalry or unfaithfulness - hostile toward a rival or one believed to enjoy an advantage.

Rage - violent and uncontrolled anger - a fit of violent wrath - insanity - violent action.

Envy - painful or resentful awareness of an advantage enjoyed by another joined with a desire to possess the same advantage



Good Fruit — In Step With The Spirit

Love - strong affection, affection based on admiration, benevolence, or common interests - warm attachment, enthusiasm, or devotion - unselfish loyal and benevolent concern for the good of another.

Joy - the emotion evoked by well-being, success, or good fortune or by the prospect of possessing what one desires - the expression or exhibition of such emotion - a state of happiness or felicity - a source or cause of delight.

Peace - a state of tranquility or quiet - freedom from disquieting or oppressive thoughts or emotions - harmony in personal relations - in a state of concord or tranquility.

Patience - bearing pains or trials calmly or without complaint - manifesting forbearance under provocation or strain - not hasty or impetuous - steadfast despite opposition, difficulty, or adversity - able or willing to bear.

Kindness - of a friendly, generous, or warm-hearted nature - showing sympathy or understanding; charitable - humane; considerate - forbearing; tolerant – generous, liberal - agreeable; beneficial.

Goodness - the quality of being good in any of its various senses; excellence; virtue; kindness; benevolence.

Faithfulness - adhering firmly and devotedly, as to a person, cause, or idea; loyal - having or full of faith – worthy of trust or belief; reliable - consistent with truth or actuality - True and constant in affection or allegiance to a person to whom one is bound by a vow.

Gentleness - considerate or kindly in disposition; amiable and tender - not harsh or severe; mild and soft - easily managed or handled; docile.

Self-control - control of one's emotions, desires, or actions by one's own will - the act of denying yourself - controlling your impulses - control of one's behavior - restraint exercised over one's self.
